

DEFERRED DISPOSITION

CONDITIONS

- Defendants with a Commercial Driver's License are not eligible for Deferred Disposition.
- Speeding 25 mph or more over the limit violations are not eligible for Deferred Disposition.
- Driving While License Invalid / Suspended violations are not eligible for Deferred Disposition. Deferral payment made without special permission will be rejected.
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia violations are not eligible for deferral. Deferral payment made without special permission will be rejected.
- No Liability Insurance violations are not eligible for Deferred Disposition. Deferral payment made without special permission will be rejected.

REQUIREMENTS

- Enter a plea of Guilty or No Contest.
- Payment of fine and court costs plus \$75 special expense fee (NO personal checks; mail a money order or cashier's check or pay online at cityofcisco.com/court.html).
- Successfully complete a probation period, usually 30-90 days, receiving no further traffic violations in the state.
- Drivers under the age of 25 will be approved by the court in limited circumstances and must also complete a Driver's Safety Course.
