

Do you want to get a proclamation or other commemorative recognition for KBG Syndrome Awareness Day (June 11)? We can help with that!

Things to know:

Most states have online request forms that need to be filled out 30 to 90 days but not more than six months before the proclamation is needed. Be sure to read through the requirements before you submit to ensure you have everything you need. If you have any questions, we are happy to help, whether you mention the KBG Foundation or not (some states do not issue proclamations with an organizations' names in them). Things you may need:

Most states ask for a sample of the wording for the proclamation or declaration. We have drafted two versions for you to choose from: one that mentions the KBG Foundation and one that is generic for you to enter your name. You are welcome to use either version and, for the purposes of a proclamation, the KBG Syndrome Ribbon should they request an image.
