

Clifford Township Parks and Recreation Board Meeting Minutes 9/25/19

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

The July meeting minutes were approved. There was no August meeting.

Sandy Wilmot updated the board on progress being made at the Children's Garden.

Sally Roberts updated the board on the status of the EMHR grant, now extended until 6/2020.

The township has been pre-approved for land acquisition if property becomes available. The possibility of applying for another EMHR grant to assist with development of the property across the creek was discussed.

Signage for the park is put on hold until the state road repair/construction is complete.

A map of the park will be designed, possible locations are on the restroom facility and at the entrance to the walking trail.

Drainage work and road pavement are two priorities for the building and grounds in the spring.

Parkfest was a great success. Feedback was given from those who helped to coordinate and/or attended. A committee will be formed to assist with the event next year.

Genevieve Larkin presented a proposal for her Gold Award Project through the Girl Scouts. She hopes to work with the township to add mile markers to the walking trail, exercise stations and/or a water fountain for people and dogs.

The building use forms were presented for review and approved for use.

The Active Living Center has been holding its weekly meetings and feedback has been positive.

Truck or Treat is scheduled for 10/26/19 at the park. Dawn Ziegler is coordinating again, through the Andrew Mazza Foundation.
