PENNY ARCADE

1960s/'70s Overall Champion Breed, Color, and Workmanship

Beth Peart, Penny Arcade's creator and owner, writes, "OMG that is TOO cool!

"I was reunited with Penny Arcade in 2016, in Rockport NY at the Lilac City Live Show. I wasn't showing then, but I went to accompany Kathy Wells who was showing, and to catch up after many years out



of touch. She surprised me with her. Kathy had got her at a swap meet. Lord knows where she had been in the 30+ years it had been since I sold her, I think originally to Kathy who was one of a very few who could talk me out of my models.

"At the time, Penny was 41 years old, the project of mid-teen me. She had survived fairly well, all considered and really was the impetus for me to return to showing last year. She even had her original tail and home-made, original horse-shoes on.

"I made her from a Breyer Man O' War, as most could probably tell, but I fattened the body up a lot, giving her an appleround rump. My inspiration was a hunter mare out of Lockport NY, if I recall correctly, called Miss December. She was as her name might suggest, quite voluptuous, and I was envious of her, despite having a nice horse, myself--but she was a conformation hunter and mine was working. She was ridden by Debbie Shaffner who I also deeply envied, for the same reasons, haha. I rode the Jr 'A' Hunter circuit in southern Ontario and Western NY at the time.

"She is painted in oils and I used a concoction of PolyFilla and carpenter's glue for the body filler. Apoxie Sculpt wasn't an option then, and Bondo was toxic and awkward to use so I improvised. Sadly most of the customs I did back then have not survived well because of this mixture, but she had relatively little damage, and I was able to repair what there was.



"I showed her around in photo shows through the '70s and also at live shows in the early '80s and did a lot of winning with her. I did live show her a bit recently, after cleaning her up, but hardly

anyone cares a thing about vintage horses at mainstream shows, so I re-retired her, though might tack her up and do some photo showing.

"There was one great shot of her with her rider up, also modelled on Debbie Shaffner. [It's featured as our cover photo this issue! -Ed.] Parenthetically, I am certain the doll was the inspiration for Brenda Breyer. I recently found that, too. I had a very long and intense chat with Pete Stone at Marney's Congress about the doll, and in less than a year, by my recollection, Brenda appeared in the catalogue. In fact, I showed with several riders back then, which wasn't at all common like it is now. Kathy Wells is my witness to that convo with Pete. :-) "

priate to change her name from Givenchy to Starship Phoenix!"

"In the Feb./ March 1991 issue of *The Hobby Horse News*, I recalled that first encounter in my Inside Straight column, titled 'The Test of the Press: Do We Show

Them Our Best?' Here's that section, courtesy of THHN and archived at Kirsten Wellman's www.modelhorsehistory.com:

"It was a mid-December morning when I stumbled across what is widely considered the best magazine article on our hobby that has been written to date. Before sitting down to read the December 1989 issue of Paint Horse Journal in depth, I was doing the customary, cursory flip through the pages in search of snazzy patterns to transplant onto models. Suddenly, an oddly shiny pate caught my eye. 'Heh, what a toupee—that guy looks like a Ken doll," I snickered, then did a double-take. It was a doll...seated on a rock in the middle of a stream, holding the reins of Rio Rondo's multi-Grand model Paint stallion, Cheyenne Ridge! In quickly glancing through, I'd been completely fooled by the model horse.

"The article, 'Model Makers Compete in Scaled-Down Paint Horse Shows,' was three pages long and sported five tremendous black-and-white photos of Rio Rondo model Paint horses 'in action.' The dramatic photos of startlingly realistic models, tack, and dolls must have instantly snatched the attention of even the most casual readers and lured them into the text, where author Jean Lindgren captured their respect for keeps.

"In 26 clear and concise inches of type, Lindgren profiled the American Model Pinto-Colored Horse association and artist Carol Williams, and explained the hobby to our real-horse counterparts. No cutesy gimmickry, no gushing or giggling. 'The premise underlying model horse showing, and all the time, energy, and work that goes into it,' she wrote, 'is to encourage people to discover their own abilities and develop them to their maximum potential. Knowing that you can do something well does good things for a person, and that knowledge carries over into everyday life.'

"...Jean Lindgren's article was a boon to our hobby in several ways. It was a wellwritten and strikingly illustrated synopsis of our hobby at its very best. It made us look great and sound like respectable adults. It piqued the interest of readers, and attracted prospective participants to our ranks. And a hobbyist could show the article to anyone and say with genuine pride, 'This is what I do for fun.'"

"Later, I was thrilled to be able to buy from Carol Williams both Cheyenne Ridge [redone by Carol as a bay overo, Crusher Joe, the 1996 NAMHSA NAN National Champion Paint Stallion] and Vansanita, who came with her own Rio Rondo Western saddle. Renamed The African Sun after one of my favorite manga, she put that saddle to huge use, grabbing performance Grand Championships both live and photo. This mare is all grit and no quit, and I'm so happy that she's done so well here in VCMEC!"

Coming Up Next: The Crowning of the VCMEC 2016-17 Online World Champions!

It's been a model horse show series unlike any other, gathering vintage customs from around the world (Australia, Canada, Germany, Japan, Sweden, the UK, and the USA) to compete under an array of judges to determine the best of the best: the 2016-17 VCMEC Online World Championships!

The next issue of VCMEC Model Horse Re-View, slated for May 31, will feature the results with a World Champion, Reserve World Champion, and Top Ten named in each class, and then Breed, Color, and Workmanship World Champions and Reserves in each of the three (1960s/1970s, 1980s, and 1990s) divisions, and finally, an Overall World Champion and Reserve for each of the three divisions.

And talk about loot--gorgeous awards are on the way from Hodges Badge Company! The class World Champions and Reserves will each receive beautiful double-layered ribbons. The Breed, Color, and Workmanship World Champions and Reserves will also receive lovely rosettes. And then there are the acrylic trophies for the Overall World Champion and Reserve in each division--check out a (slightly censored) Overall Reserve World Champion trophy at right!

Best of all, we'll have these awards on hand at VCMEC Live on May 6 to present in person to attending owners of the winning vintage customs, weeks before the next issue comes out with the results! For those not able to attend VCMEC Live, awards will be mailed in early June.

Since next issue promises to be wall-to-wall results, now is a good time to explain how the VCMEC Online World Champions were determined!

The World Champion and Reserve in each class were determined by horses' placings in that class. Horses had to have competed in at least 4 legs of the series, unless shown by an entrant who judged one of the last 4 legs but did not enter the first 2 legs, in which case the horse must have competed in its class in at least 3 legs of the series. An exception was made if a horse was entered in the class but was not judged due to the judge having created the horse.

In each class, the World Champion, Reserve World Champion, and Top Ten were determined by the average of each horse's top 4 (or 3) placings in that class. (Honorable Mention [HM] was counted as 11th place, and being unplaced [UP] was counted as 15th place.) If tied, the amount of championships each of the tied horses won in that show during the series was used to break the tie. (One Reserve was considered half a

championship, an Overall Championship of the show was counted as 5 championships, and Overall Reserve was worth 3 championships.) If the tied horses won the same amount of championships in the show, the tie stayed if a World Championship or Reserve was at stake. Otherwise, for the rest of the Top Ten, the number of wins was then used to break a tie. (In the example at top, horses are in their Top Ten order; WC is World Champion and RWC is Reserve World Champion. The tie for 3rd in the Top Ten was



broken by a class win; the tie could not be broken for 7th.)

An aside: We didn't require a horse to win a class to be able to be the World Champion in that class. We also only provided for amount of championships, not also class wins, to be tie-breakers for World Champions and Reserves. Next time...!

The Breed, Color, and Workmanship World Champions and Reserves were determined by the number of championships each horse won in that show during the series. In the event of a tie, the average of each horse's top 4 (or 3) placings in its class in that show was used to break the tie. If the tied horses had same average, the tie stayed.

Although we had planned early on to determine each division's Overall World Champions and Reserves by average placings in all classes, that skewed toward horses that were the only entrant in a class. We ultimately came up with a more well-rounded method. First, the Breed, Color, and Workmanship World Champions and Reserves, and all others that were Overall Champions or Reserves during the series, were ranked by their combined average placings, not breaking any ties. After that, the horses were ranked by total amount of championships won, not breaking any ties. The horse with the best average ranking between those two lists was the Overall Grand, and the runner-up was Reserve. Ties were broken by the horses' overall amount of championships.

It was weeks of number-crunching, but so exciting as the results emerged--and we hope you'll enjoy them, too! Thanks to all for entering and letting your vintage stars shine!
