1904-1998

Albert H. Schuette, 93 of Pigeon, passed away Sunday, Jan. 18, 1998, at Huron Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe.

He was born Feb. 17, 1904, in Elkton, son of the late Christoph and Sophia (Bergman) Schuette.



He was married June 14, 1928, to Matilda Schulz at Cross Lutheran Church, Pigeon. She preceded him in death on Nov. 12, 1937. He later married Frances Loeffler on Feb. 19, 1938, at New Salem Lutheran Church, Sebawaing. She preceded him in death on March 8, 1990.
