Asset Management is a universally accepted term that characterizes a water/wastewater system's ability (capacity) to meet customer expectations and maintain optimal levels of service. It ranges from asset administration (identification) to stakeholder education and outreach and everything in between. It can involve classifications at all levels within an organization from the chief executive to the maintenance staff and covers, buried and above ground horizontal and vertical assets, equipment, machines, buildings, and people.
