

He was ordained in 1992 in Ljubljana by Archbishop Šustar and then served in Maribor for the next 5 years, spent the next 4 years in Australia, and most recently the last 16 years in Lemont as our Pastor and spiritual leader. As a seminarian, he spent a summer in Johnstown, Pennsylvania to learn English. When he was younger, retired Archbishop Uran was his pastor and helped gulde his vocation.

Pater Metod is an important and active member of our Slovenian community. He is the Spiritual Advisor for the Center Board. He is often

found helping out preparing for all our events at the Center. He is also the Spiritual Leader for the Slomšek Slovenksa šola, and beautifully connects our religion to our culture so that our children have a greater understanding of the two. He is certainly a favorite of all the students. P. Metod has become an integral part of the support system in our community. He dedicates much of his time visiting our elderly members and in times of need, his calm presence, advice and spiritual guidance is much appreciated. In his free time, P. As our year came to a close, students participated in preparations for the Center's **Palm Sunday** luncheon by helping to color "pirhi" on Saturday, April 8th. Many thanks to Mojca Anaya, Erika Falk and Larissa Magajne for helping our young chickens create such beautiful eggs. After enjoying spring break, students returned to classes on Saturday, April 22nd to continue polishing up their Mother's Day performances.

Slovenska Šola students celebrated the end of the 2016-2017 school year with the annual **End-of-Year party**, following their final Mother's Day stage rehearsal, held on Saturday, May 13th. Many parents, grandparents and former students made quick work of setting tables and decorating the hall for the next day's festivities. A special thank you to Sheena Litt for organizing the kids' party as well as all the moms and dads who scurried between halls preparing for both events.

**Mother's Day** always marks the official end of the school year for our students. Students and parents participate in the Mother's Day mass before heading to the Center for the luncheon and program. Curtains opened to Plesna skupina Nagelj dancing to "Mama ta pesem je zate." Our youngest classes showed off what they've learned through songs and recitations. Some of the highlights of the program included our Čebelice and Srčki classes performing songs such as "Jaz pa pojdem na Gorejsko" and "Kje so živali." The lovely voices of Zbor Slomšek echoed through the Center with "Slovenija, od kod lepote tvoje," "Žabe," and "Mamica je kakor zarja."
