

Ordinance No 24

An Ordinance Requiring the Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railway Company to maintain Lights at the crossings of its tracks with certain streets in the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana; and providing penalties for its Violation.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana,

Sec 1. That the Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railway Company is hereby required and shall keep and maintain an electric light at the point of intersection and crossing of its tracks with Main Street in the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, of sufficient power to light the entire of said crossing, but not to exceed the power of the electric lights used generally by said town at its other street crossings, and also to keep said light supplied with sufficient amount of electric current and lit and burning for not less than thirty minutes before the arrival of each and every train engine or car at said railway crossing, and until after such train, engine or car has departed, at all times in the night time, when there is no moon, or the moon is obscured by clouds.

Sec 2. That the Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railway Company is hereby required and shall keep and maintain an electric light at the point of intersection and crossing of its tracks with <sup>Market</sup> Street in the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, of sufficient power to light the entire of said crossing, but not to exceed the power of the electric lights used generally by said town at its other street crossings, and also to keep said light supplied with sufficient amount of electric current and lit and burning for not less than thirty minutes before the arrival of each and every train, engine or car at said railway crossing, and until after such train, engine or car has departed, at all times in the night time, when there is no moon, or the moon is obscured by clouds.

Sec. 3. That the Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railway Company is hereby required and shall keep and maintain an electric light at the point of intersection and crossing of its tracks with <sup>Clinton</sup> Street in the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, of sufficient power to light the entire of said crossing, but not to exceed the power of the electric lights used generally by said town at its other street crossings, and also to keep said light supplied with sufficient amount of electric current and lit and burning for not less than thirty minutes before the arrival of each and every train, engine or car at said railway crossing, and until after such train, engine or car has departed, at all times in the night time, when there is no moon, or the moon is obscured by clouds.

Sec 4. That the Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railway Company is hereby required and shall keep and maintain an electric light at the point of intersection and crossing of its tracks with <sup>La Fayette</sup> Street in the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, of sufficient power to light the entire of said crossing, but not to exceed the power of the electric lights used generally by said town at its other street crossings, and also to keep said light supplied with sufficient amount of electric current and lit and burning for not less than thirty minutes before the arrival of each and every train, engine or car at said railway crossing, and until after such train, engine or car has departed, at all times in the night time, when there is no moon, or the moon is obscured by clouds.

Sec 5. If said Company, named in this ordinance, shall fail to comply with the terms of this ordinance, or with the terms of any section thereof, shall be deemed guilty of an offense, and shall be fined in the sum of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars. And each separate day of such failure shall constitute a separate offense.

Sec. 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the first day of July, 1914, and after its due publication according to law.
