Job Characteristics

This position performs park and grounds keeping maintenance and construction work in the City, parks and recreation areas. Incumbents in this class are expected to operate trucks, trailers, mowers, chainsaws, weed eater and other equipment as part of their regular assignments. Must be able to perform heavy manual work involving semi-skilled maintenance tasks within the City. Work is to be performed in accordance with specific instruction and defined procedures. Routine tasks are performed with independence and more difficult work is performed under direct supervision. Position may be required to work additional hours during any emergency event.

Essential Job Functions

- Maintains grounds (mowing, bush hogging, trimming, edging, raking, weeding, sodding, watering, picking up trash and disposing of same).
- Preventative maintenance and repair equipment as need or per manufactures specifications.
- Performs custodial duties within parks.
- Performs basic carpentry, masonry and electrical work.
- Performs plumbing tasks, on a semi-skilled level, on park facilities and irrigation systems.
- Repairs and maintains playground equipment.
- Performs spraying with hand held sprayer.
- Performs painting tasks on picnic tables and park buildings.
- Trims trees and removes branches.
- Performs minor construction and maintenance on athletic fields and courts.
- Read water meters.
- Mowing and trimming or right of ways
- Maintains a log of all work done
- Any other duties assigned by the Department Director and/or designee.

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills

- Knowledge of tools, methods and materials in general maintenance work.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to learn to operate light construction equipment.
- Ability to deal with the public in providing information and/or enforcement of City regulations.
