

Three artworks by James Rosenquist (Am., b. 1933), including the one shown here titled Gift Wrapped Doll (1993, est. \$2,500-\$5,000) will be part of The Benefit Shop Foundation's big Red Carpet Auction on Wednesday, February 8th, online and at the firm's gallery in Mount Kisco, N.Y., beginning at 10 am Eastern time. Rosenquist is one of the protagonists of the pop-art movement and is a very hot commodity right now among art collectors and aficionados. Gift Wrapped Doll is a framed lithograph in colors. It is signed, titled, dated and numbered (19/24) in pencil.



The Red Carpet Auction is just that – an A-Z selection of quality merchandise totaling nearly 700 lots in a variety of categories. Lots already garnering attention include an authentic 1925 French advertising poster for wine, showing a clown with a tennis racket looking up at a bird flying away with a bottle (est. \$500-\$1,000); and a lovely group of five jade bracelets being offered as one lot.
