

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS, CALLING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN SAID CITY; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS INCIDENT AND RELATED TO THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, this City Council finds and determines that it is necessary and advisable to call and hold an election within said City on the proposition hereinafter set forth;

WHEREAS, it is further found and determined that holding such election on the date hereinafter set forth is in the public interest; Now, Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN:

Section 1. Findings.

The statements contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are true and correct and are adopted as findings of fact hereby, which findings are conclusive and incontestible.

Section 2. Election Date; Proposition.

An election shall be held in the City of Log Cabin, Texas, on May 2, 1998, at which election the following proposition shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION

SHALL THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS, BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE AND SELL THE BONDS OF SAID CITY IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$250,000, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING AND IMPROVING STREETS OF THE CITY AND PROVIDING DRAINAGE IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, AND PURCHASING LAND AND INTERESTS IN LAND AND PROPERTIES NECESSARY THEREFOR; WITH SAID BONDS TO BE ISSUED IN ONE OR MORE SERIES OR ISSUES, TO MATURE SERIALLY OR OTHERWISE AND BEAR INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES, NOT TO EXCEED THE RESPECTIVE LIMITS PRESCRIBED BY LAW AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE, AND TO BE SOLD AT SUCH PRICE OR PRICES, AS THE CITY COUNCIL IN ITS DISCRETION SHALL DETERMINE; AND SHALL THERE BE LEVIED AND PLEDGED, ASSESSED AND COLLECTED ANNUALLY AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID CITY IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE ANNUAL INTEREST ON SAID BONDS AND PROVIDE A SINKING FUND TO PAY SAID BONDS AT MATURITY?

Section 3. Precinct and Polling Places.

(a) The entire City shall constitute a single election precinct for said election, and the polling place for such precinct on election day is hereby established and designated in Exhibit A attached hereto, which is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof for all purposes.

(b) The Early Voting Polling Place for conducting early voting by personal appearance and the address for early voting by mail for said election are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 4. Voting Hours.

(a) On election day the polls shall be open from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

(b) The dates and hours for early voting by personal appearance at the Early Voting Polling Place shall be as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 5. Official Ballots.

Voting at said election on election day and early voting by personal appearance and by mail shall be by the use of paper ballots. The official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with V.T.C.A. Election Code, so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid proposition which shall be set forth in substantially the following form:

PROPOSITION

THE ISSUANCE OF \$250,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR STREET AND RELATED DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

Section 6. Persons Qualified to Vote.

All resident qualified electors of said City shall be permitted to vote in said election.

Section 7. Bilingual Election Materials.

The election materials enumerated in Secs. 272.001, et seq., V.T.C.A. Election Code, shall be printed and furnished in both English and Spanish for use at the polling place on election day and for early voting.

Section 8. Notice of Election.

Notice of said election shall be given by posting substantial copies of this Ordinance in both English and Spanish on the bulletin board in the City Hall of said City used for posting notices of

meetings of the City Council of said City and at three (3) other public places in said City; and substantial copies of this Ordinance in both English and Spanish shall be published on the same day in each of two (2) successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in said City, the date of the first publication to be not more than thirty (30) or less than fourteen (14) days prior to the date set for said election.

Section 9. Repeal of Prior Ordinances.

All previous ordinances of the City relating to the subject matter of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
