The Macomb County Bar Association was honored for their generosity in providing funds for many historic projects in Macomb County. One of their most significant contributions - \$2,000 - was made through the Macomb County Bar Association Foundation to print and publish a full-color commemorative program that was distributed to attendees during the Dedication of the Alexander Macomb and John Stockton / Eighth Michigan Volunteer Calvary Regiment Memorial Cannons ceremony that took place on August 27, 2005 during the Bath City Festival in Mount Clemens.

The replacements that were dedicated during the ceremony, are two accurate representations of original cannons that were placed in front of the Macomb County Building in 1901 and 1914; one that was once used by General Alexander Macomb in the War of 1812, and the second, in memory of the Michigan Eighth Calvary Regiment and their commander, Colonel John Stockton, who used the cannon during the Civil War.
