DESCRIPTION: This very rare Sabre target bow is a real beauty. Sabre Archery Company of Bernardsville NJ was a regional bowyer and company in the 1950's and 60's that made high-quality custom recurve bows as well as a number of stock models. They also had their own line of archery accessories. This vintage bow is one of their high-end target bows. It appears to be a mid-1960's model, but I have not been able to find any historical information on it. It has a serial number, so it was likely a stock bow and not a custom made one. This bow features the older style "basket weave" fiberglass limbs. The bow has wooden overlays on both the face and back of the riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. The 5 layer tip overlays and tips are in great condition. Two filled sight screw holes on the face that are barely visible (see pic on p. 5). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot.

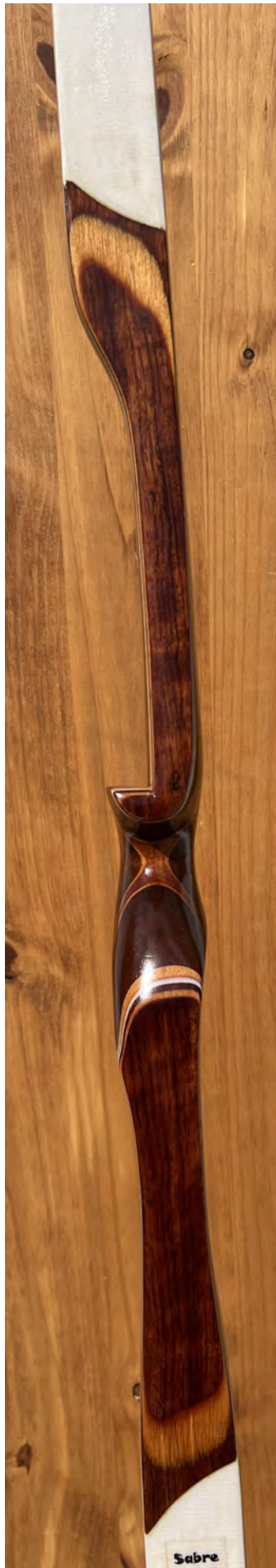
