**To change a Beneficiary**

Call Zenith at 888-286-3169, they will mail you a form to fill out or print if from the UAW Local 5285 webpage.

Retiree's with a retirement date before 12-18-1994 does not have retiree life insurance.

Retiree's with a retirement date between 12-19-1994 and 8-26-2006 have a \$5,000.00 death benefit.

Retiree's with a retirement date between 8-27-2006 and 4-26-2024 have a \$10,000.00 death benefit.

**Retiree's with a retirement date after 4-27-2024 have a \$12,500.00 death benefit.**

**Retiree Dental Insurance**

**The retiree and spouse keep retiree dental insurance after age 65 starting on 1-1-2025. Continue to use the same retiree Delta Dental card as under age 65.**

**You are in the Delta Dental of Oregon Plan, (Not North Carolina.) Tell the Dental office this information.**

All retiree's have VSP vision coverage, use your BCBSM medical card until you have Medicare. Once you have Medicare you have a separate BCBSM vision card.

**Medicare= Medicare Advantage Plan**

To remain on the UAW retiree healthcare plan the retiree must sign up for Medicare Part A and B starting the 1st day of the month of your 65th birthday. Send a copy of your card to Benesys.

2025 cost for Medicare Part B is \$185.00, 2026 cost estimate for Medicare Part B is \$206.50.

The spouse must sign up for Medicare Part A and B starting the first day of the month of their 65th birthday.

If the employee or any dependent has Medicare prior to their retirement date, they must enroll in Medicare Part A and B to be eligible for retiree healthcare.

Once you have Medicare, **Do Not** show your government issued Medicare card, only use your BCBSM card at the doctor's office or the hospital.

Once you go to the Medicare Advantage Plan, you will have two BCBSM cards, one for medical and one for vision .

**Express Scripts Drug Plan**

Express scripts mail order is required for maintenance type drugs on the retiree plan. This allows for a 3 month supply for a two month co-payment.

**Starting in the second quarter of 2025, retirees can get all standard vaccines at the pharmacy and use the Express Scripts card. This could change due to Government Guidelines.**
