The original structure of *The* Washington House was erected in 1879, a few short years after Falls Church gained it's its township status. Counted among the earliest visitors to Falls Church were George Washington and George Mason. Many of the town's early Civic organizations have met in our building including the Civic League in 1913 and a Recreation Center for the Boy Scouts in the 1930s. It also served as the Headquarters of the Police Department and Town Hall in the 1940s.

Our building was named "The Washington House" after renovation by the Woman's Club of Falls Church in 1958. The Center for Spiritual Enlightenment started holding services there in 1988 and purchased the building in 2003.
