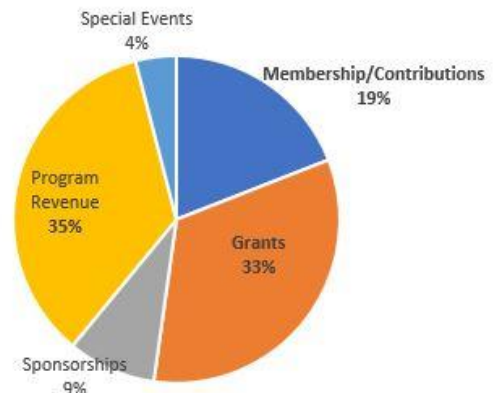
### WHAT WE DO

- Serve as an ag resource connector

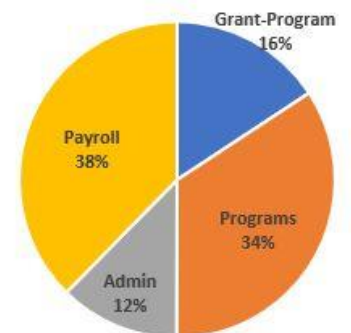
- Volunteer **leadership** from 28 Board of Directors and Advisors
