True Grit Futurity & Derby – Rules & Regulations

- 1. <u>Futurity</u> Open to any horse which is a foal of 2014 or later (5 years & under). Horse must never have competed in any barrel race, rodeo, jackpot or other futurities before December 1, 2018. However, these horses may have run exhibition runs prior to December 1, 2018.
- 2. **<u>Derby</u>** Open to any horse which is a foal of 2012 and later (7 years & under).
- 3. <u>Futurity & Derby</u> Photocopy of front and back of registration papers on registered horses must accompany nomination. Veterinarian affidavit (for e.g. Health Paper) of year of birth and complete description of unregistered horses must accompany nomination.
- 4. Futurity and Derby will be two runs. Champions will be declared on Average of 2 runs.
- 5. Running order will be drawn for the 1st go. 2nd go will run in reverse order. Late entries will be at the bottom of the draw both Go's.
- 6. Nomination payments are due in full by August 1, 2019. Etransfer or cheque in full amount must accompany the entry form. Late entries will be accepted after August 1st with a \$50 late fee.
- 7. Any NSF cheques will carry a \$25 service charge.
- Substitutions will be accepted for death, illness or unsoundness. Veterinarian affidavit or proof must accompany substitutions along with a \$25 fee. Substitution of rider is allowed and free, provided the office is notified prior to 1st go. Selling of spots is allowed until August 23, 2019. Office must be notified of transaction.
- 9. No refunds for any reason other than if event is cancelled due to weather office fee will be kept.
- 10. Dress Code long sleeve western shirt, cowboy boots, cowboy hat or helmet with be enforced.
- 11. Stalling will not be provided, but you may self pen in designated areas. No solid tying of horses to Perimeter Fencing around the grounds is allowed.
- 12. Payout Futurity & Derby
 - a. 1st & 2nd Go 60% of total prize money (30% each go-round)
 - b. Average 40% of total prize money
 - c. 30 & under entries pays 4 monies in each go and average
 - d. 31-60 entries pays 6 monies in each go and average
 - e. 61 + entries pays 8 monies in each go and average
- 13. Rerun if timer fails no penalty will be carried forward.
- 14. Running rules & regulations:
 - a. Entrants/competitors and owners will be responsible for themselves and their horses. All horses may be subject to drug test, examination to meet registration identification or examination for age at the discretion of management. Any horse examined and found to be ineligible age, failing to meet registration description or failing to pass a drug test exam will be disqualified.
 - b. Inhumane treatment of horses will not be tolerated on the grounds and will result in disqualification.
 - c. Competitors must be ready when called or they will forfeit their run.
 - d. Completion of entry form or payment of entry fees will indicate acceptance of all rules and regulations governing this event.
 - e. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained it is understood that each contestant/owner waives all claims against the True Grit Futurity & Derby, organizing body, workers, etc for any injury, loss or damage which may result in any way from the operations of activities of the True Grit Futurity & Derby event.
