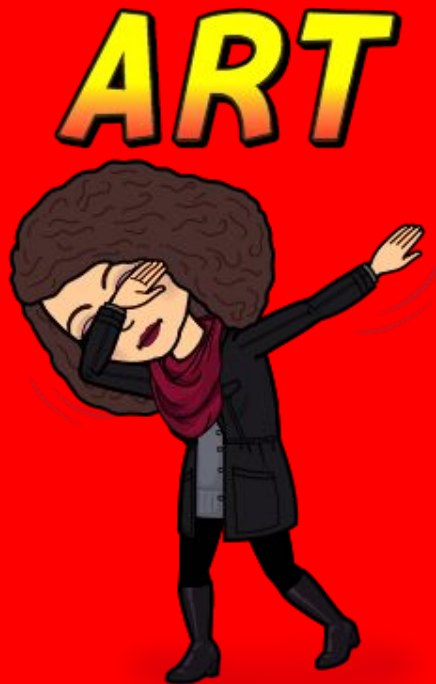

LET'S WARM UP!

Open your sketchbook!

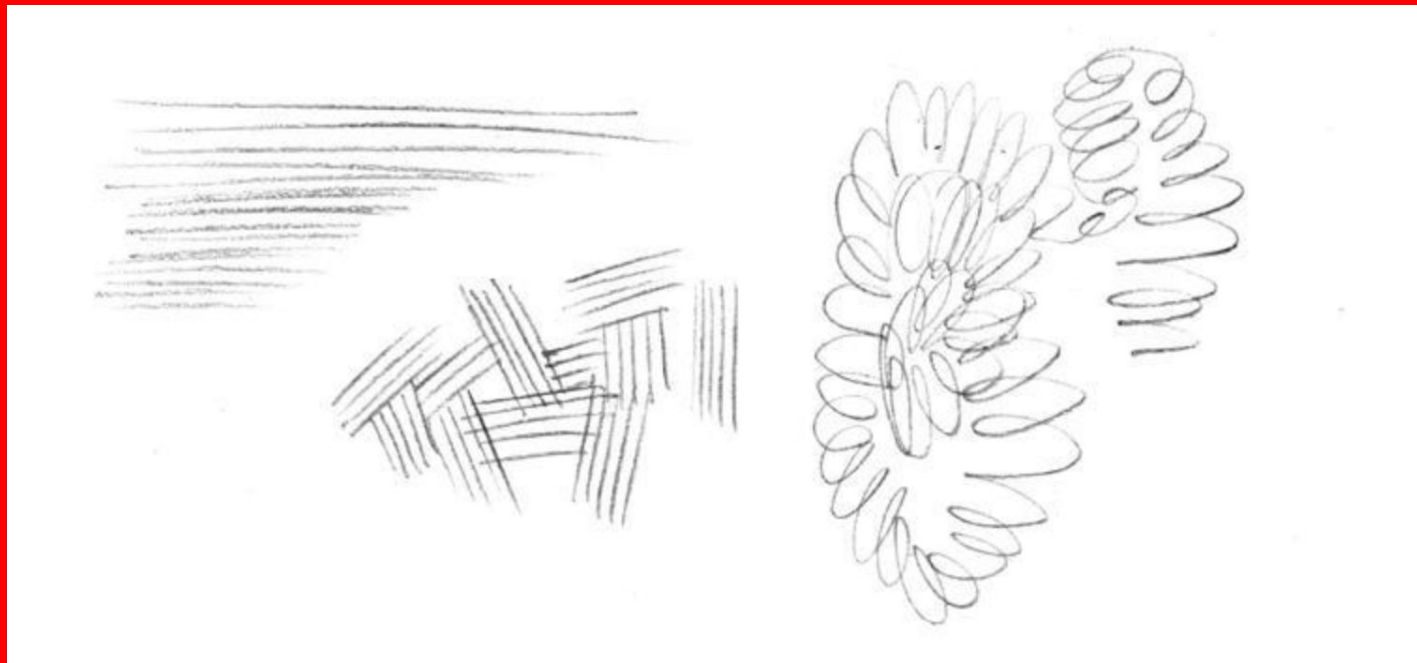
Start by holding your pencil in your hand and rotating your wrist 10 times each direction!

Now let's hold out our arm and rotate from the shoulder - count to ten!

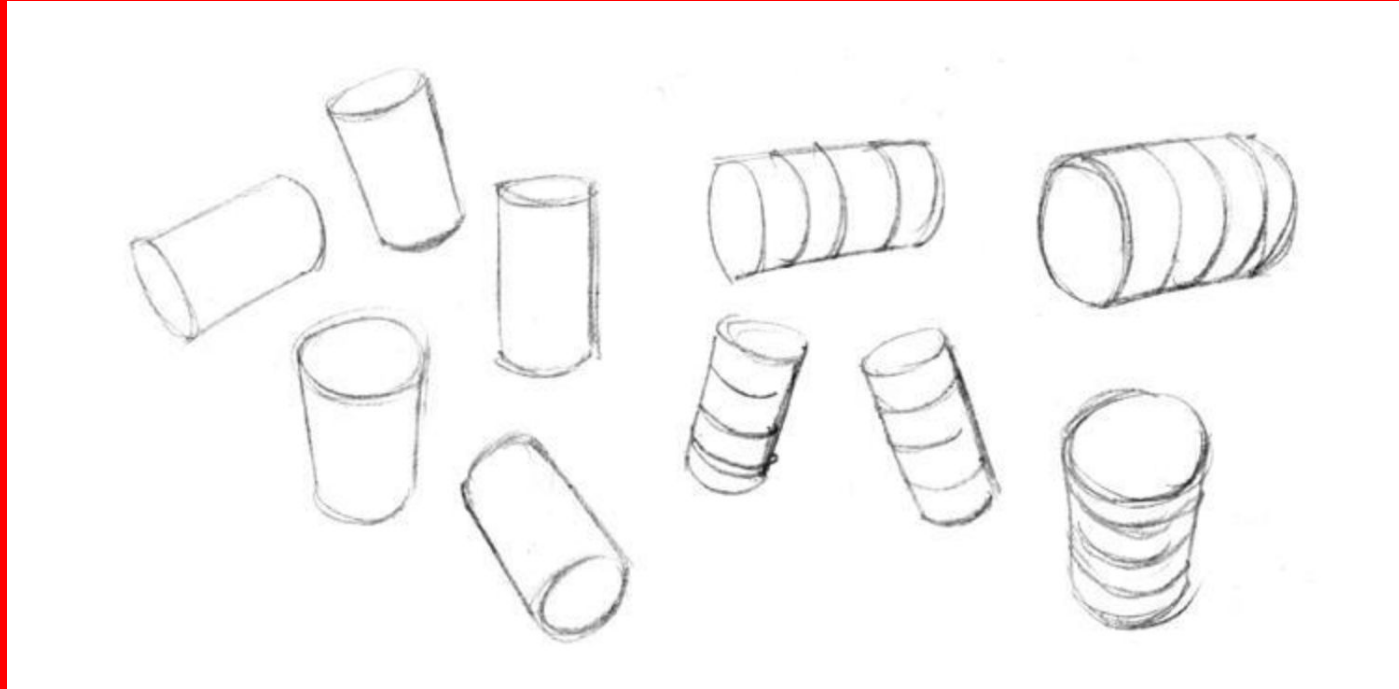

COMPOUND OBJECTS

Compound means to combine, or put together different shapes to create new objects - use your imagination here!

Today we will look closely and learn to draw one of the most important features of the face!

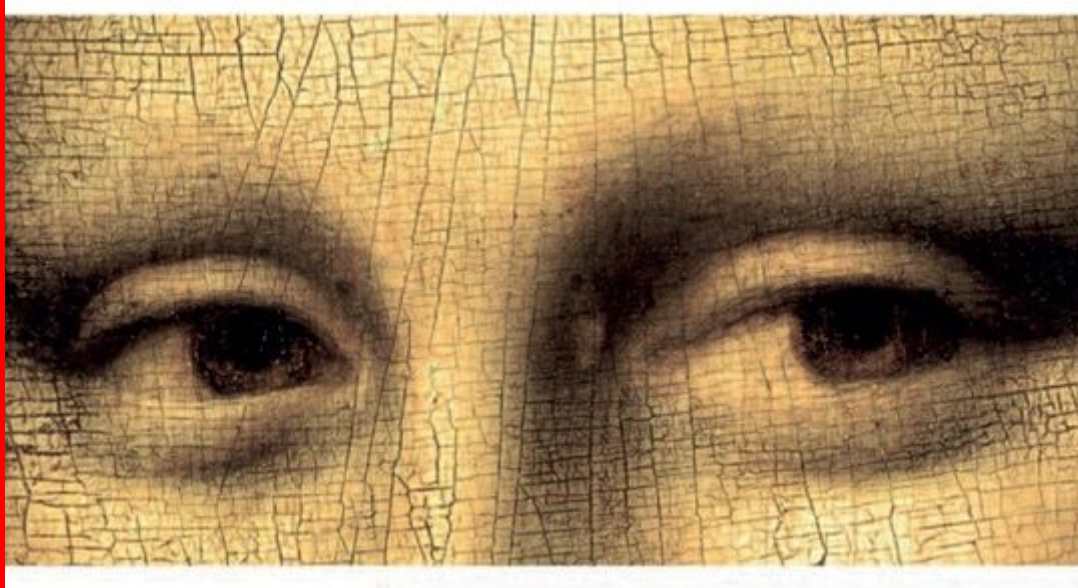
We will start with the eyes.....
