

Ordinance No 10

An ordinance to appropriate moneys
to defray the expenses of the city of Garnett
during the year commencing Apr 5th 1871

Be it ordained by the Mayor and
Councilmen of the city of Garnett

Sec 1. That the sum of one thousand
dollars (\$1000⁰⁰/₁₀₀) be and the same is hereby
appropriated for general expenditures

Sec 2^d That the sum of one thousand
five hundred dollars (\$1500⁰⁰/₁₀₀) be and
the same is hereby appropriated for the
building of bridges, culverts & foot walks,
and to open and improve streets, avenues
& alleys and for the improvement of the
Public Square

Sec 3^d This ordinance shall be in
force from and after its publication in
the Garnett Plaindealer
