## COSMOLOGY OF CHRIST'S BIRTH

The Cosmology of Christ's Birth series does not venture to guess or speculate on the actual date of Jesus Christ's birth but rather emphasize and focus on the peculiarities of the cosmology that perhaps might give additional clues as to the window of the probable time of the King's 1st Advent. This illustration features the depiction of the cosmic configuration of Virgo as a microcosm of the Great Pyramid of Giza pattern. The 3 main stars that make up the sacred divine triangle are Regulus-Arcturus-Antares. When the Giza Great Pyramid pattern overlaid and elongated over Virgo, it approximates the angles of the Grand Gallery, the main 4 shafts that correspond to the arms and legs. Spica corresponds to the Queen's Chamber and the King's Chamber corresponds to the womb region of Virgo where many planets are seen as being 'birthed' out of Virgo etc.
