#### **Agreement Terms**

By signing below, I acknowledge and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. **Billing and Payments:**
  - I agree to pay all water service bills by the due date. Failure to do so may result in service disconnection.
  - I will be responsible for any attorney fees and collection costs incurred due to non-payment.
2. **Residential Use Conditions (if applicable):**
  - For residential connections, I understand that the water connection is limited to one residence or dwelling per meter.
  - I grant FSSD permission to access the property with five days' written notice for inspections.
3. **Compliance with Regulations:**
  - I will abide by all FSSD rules and regulations, including water dedication requirements, payment of applicable impact fees, connection fees, and any other fees listed in the current Fee Schedule.
  - I understand that if the water meter is found to be tampered with, I will be responsible for repair costs.
4. **Meter Access:**
  - If access to the water meter is denied, FSSD reserves the right to terminate water service.
5. **Installation and Maintenance Requirements:**
  - I will install and maintain a backflow prevention device as required. The installation of a pressure regulator and a stop-and-waste valve on the customer side of the meter is recommended.
6. **Prohibition of Booster Pumps:**
  - Per Utah Code R309-105-9(3), R309-504-5(4), and R309-550-11(3), individual home booster pumps connected directly to the water supply main are prohibited. Violation of this requirement will result in termination of service.
7. **Accuracy of Information:**
  - I certify that all information provided in this application is true and accurate. Any false statements may result in immediate disconnection of service.

**Note:** A meter fee is required regardless of water usage.
