

TOWN OF STRATTON
SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES

The Stratton School Board held its monthly meeting on February 3, 2011 at 7p.m. at the Stratton Town Office. In attendance were Thomas Montemagni, Siobhan Eddy Young, Lorraine M. Weeks-Newell and WCSU Superintendent, Steven John. Also present was Mrs. Lois Burwell. The meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. The minutes of the January 2011 meeting were read and approved.

Mrs. Burwell attended the meeting for the purpose of submitting her Residency packet and providing the Board with additional information needed. Her two daughters attend Manchester Elementary School and Stratton Mountain School. In review of the completed forms, the Board approved her residency and tuition payments. At the time of the meeting, Treasurer, Laura Hawksley, had received a tuition invoice from Manchester Elementary School for one Burwell student. Although the Board accepted the Burwell residency policy and approved tuition, it will need to review additional information to decide on what date tuition payments should begin.

Mrs. Hawksley provided the Board with a copy of the 2011/2012 school budget. At the time of the printout, the School Board had not received the actual amounts for state set average tuition. Therefore, this information will be provided at the Town Meeting, March 1, 2011. Siobhan Young made the motion to approve the 2011/2012 Stratton School Budget. Chairman Montemagni seconded.

The Board has approved the using of the Medicaid money it receives each year through Special Education Services to be payable to WCSU and to be used for the Explorer's Camp. Funds available through 6/30/10 amount to \$6,423.73.


The order was reviewed, approved and signed.
