SURVIVOR LEAGUE 2020

DATES: Wednesdays starting June 17th thru July 29th, 2020 (7 weeks).

TIMES: Check-in: 6:00 PM. Practice: 6:30 PM.

DIVISIONS: Six: U15 girls, U15 boys, U18 girls, U18 boys, U20 girls, U20 boys.

FORMAT: All bowl 3 games. Top 2 in each division bowl 1 game to determine winner.

PATTERNS: High School Challenge, College Sport. Different each week.

HANDICAP: 80% of 210. Max: 40 pins per game.

COST: \$18.00 each week. \$10.50 lineage. \$1.00 expenses. \$6.50 scholarship.

AWARDS: In each division: high average, scratch series, scratch game. Plus, 1st place

in each division. (all awards based on minimum of 18 games).

\$300.00 added to awards by Beaver-Vu . All awards deposited in SMART.

This is designed as a short-season, get-back-in-shape, practice league for middle school, high school, and college bowlers. State of Ohio General Non-Contact Sport regulations and State of Ohio regulations overseeing bowling center operation will apply. These regulations are subject to change at will by the State of Ohio.

SURVIVOR LEAGUE 2020 updated: 6.17.20

- 1. Operation: The league is operated by Beaver-Vu Bowl, 1238 N. Fairfield Rd., Beavercreek, OH 45432. 937.426.6771. Greg Coulles, League Manager. greg@daytonbowling.com 937.602.1475 - cell
- 2. Dates: The league will bowl on Wednesdays starting June 17, 2020-July 29, 2020 (7 weeks).
- **Time:** Check-in begins at 6:00 PM. 10 minutes practice starts at 6:30 PM.
- Cost: \$18.00 each week. Breakdown: \$10.50 lineage. \$1.00 expenses. \$6.50 SMART scholarships.
- 5. Divisions: There are 6 separate divisions: U15B, U15G, U18B, U18G. U20B, U20G. Any bowler, age 20 & under as of 8.1.19 may bowl in this league. The bowler age on 8.1.19 will determine the division. USBC membership not required.
- 6. Format: All bowlers will bowl three (3) games. The top 2 in each division, based on their 3-game scores, will advance to bowl 1 game to determine the weekly winner. Ties for advancing position will bowl a 9th/10th frame rolloff.
- 7. Handicap: This is a "limited" handicap league. 80% of 210. Maximum handicap per game per bowler: 40 pins.

NOTE: The 1st week for all bowlers will be **SCRATCH**. Handicap will be calculated for weeks going forward.

- Pre-Bowling: Bowlers may "pre-bowl" for any dates to be missed in this league. Reservation required. Pre-bowlers will be ineligible for the Championship Round the missed week. NO POST-BOWLING ALLOWED.
- 9. **Patterns:** This league will bowl on a "challenge" or "sport" pattern each week. Here are the patterns:
 - June 17th 2019-2020 OHSAA District Championship Pattern (challenge)
 - June 24th 2019-2020 OHSAA District Championship Pattern (challenge)
 - July 1st 2019-2020 OHSAA State Championship Lane Pattern (challenge)
 - July 8th 2019-2020 OHSAA State Championship Lane Pattern (challenge)
 - July 15th 2019 Wright State Raider Collegiate Tournament (sport)
 - July 22nd 2019 Wright State Raider Collegiate Tournament (sport)
 - July 29th 2019 USBC Jr. Gold Championship Finals (sport)
- 10. Points: Bowlers in each division will earn weekly points towards final league divisional standings as follows:
 - A. 5 points for attendance.
 - B. 1 point for each bowler in your division you beat that week.
 - C. 3 points for 2nd place finish.
 - D. 5 points for 1st place finish.
- 11. Awards: Bowlers will receive SMART scholarships for participation and performance as follows:
 - A. Points earned for participation and performance within their division.
 - B. Divisional high average (minimum of 18 games).
 - C. Divisional high 3-game scratch series
 - D. Divisional high scratch game.

Note: Beaver-Vu Bowl will add \$300.00 to the scholarship awards offered in this league. Specific amounts for the above awards will be announced at conclusion of league after amount collected from the league cost is compiled.

12. Administration: The athlete, by voluntary participation in this league acquiesces to the final authority of the league manager to make on-site changes and interpret and enforce all league rules and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretative judgement guided by the best interests of bowling and this league.



SAFETY POLICIES FOR THE SURVIVOR LEAGUE 2020

Bowlers & Spectators:

As a condition to operate the SURVIVOR League 2020, we must be in compliance with the State of Ohio's <u>Consumer</u>, <u>Retail, Services, and Entertainment</u>, <u>Restaurant & Bar</u>, and <u>General Non-Contact Sports</u> mandates along with the operation policies of Beaver-Vu Bowl. Below, please find the attendance policies in effect for this league.

BOWLERS

- 1. "NO-TOUCH" RULE IS IN EFFECT: All individuals must avoid physical contact with others before, during and after the event in the facility. This includes high-fives, handshakes, hugs, fist bumps, etc.
- 2. **EQUIPMENT:** Equipment (balls, shoes, towels, accessories items, including beverages and food, etc.) may not be shared with anyone. Only touch and use your own personal equipment.
- 3. **MAXIMUM PARTICIPATION:** Per bowling center policy, the maximum number of bowlers on a lane will be three (3). Six (6) bowlers on a pair. 1 unused pair of lanes will exist between each used pair of lanes in this league.
- 4. **LANE ASSIGNMENTS:** To significantly reduce bowler and spectator movement, Bowlers will bowl all 3 games of the Qualifying Round on the same pair of lanes. Lanes will be arbitrarily pre-assigned by league management.

SPECTATORS

1. **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** Spectators must maintain six-foot social distancing. **To assist in compliance with this regulation**, the center reserves the right to allow only one (1) spectator per bowler in the bowling center.

BOWLERS AND SPECTATORS

- FACE MASKS: Face masks are allowed for bowlers and are STRONGLY encouraged for spectators.
- 2. **SYMPTOMS:** Anyone demonstrating symptoms of illness will not be admitted into the center. Anyone experiencing illness symptoms must stay home. The center reserves the right to take a no-touch temperature reading of all athletes and spectators. Anyone with a fever or refusing to submit to a temperature reading, if requested, will be asked to leave.
- 3. **SANITATION:** Hands should be sanitized on a regular basis either with soap and water (20 sec.) or with hand sanitizer located throughout the center and in the league office at no charge.
- 4. **ADMISSION:** All bowlers & spectators will be admitted into the center through the front door. The side doors will be unavailable to admit people and only available to exit the facility.

NOTICES

The State of Ohio can amend their mandates of bowling center and sports operation at will and without notice. We must comply with their changing mandates as a condition to conduct this league and to operate the bowling center. **Any additional or revised State mandates will be announced on-site.** Please exercise sound judgement and respect all safety rules for everyone's benefit.
