Local restaurants donate soups to fill the bowl, which symbolizes the simple meal a hungry person might consume. All proceeds benefit Mary's Soup Kitchen and The Treasure Coast Food Bank. The event is held annually at St. Mary's Episcopal Church on East Ocean Blvd.
