The Oberlin Public Works Department is accepting applications for a **Full-Time Water Plant Operator/Assistant Lab Technician** in the Water Division. The Water Plant Operator/Assistant Lab Technician is responsible for operating the Water Treatment Plant, performing preventative and scheduled plant maintenance, assisting the Lab Technician and performing all required laboratory analysis in the absence of the Lab Technician.

Minimum Qualifications: Requires a high school diploma or equivalent, at least two (2) years' experience in a laboratory. Some college level courses in Microbiology, Chemistry or Biology desired. Satisfactory completion of seminars, training sessions, and course work related to water laboratories. Satisfactory completion of Advanced Water Treatment and Laboratory Testing courses.

Must show mathematical ability, communication skills, planning and organizing skills, knowledge of water treatment process, operations, record keeping, and must be able to function with co-workers as a team. Must have a telephone where one can be reached for call-outs and emergencies. The position requires a valid state of Ohio driver's license. Valid Ohio Class B Commercial Driver's License with Air Brakes and Tanker Endorsement preferred.
