She graduated from Coldwater High School in 1942. Phyllis attended Western Michigan University, graduating in 1947 with a Bachelor's Degree and Elementary Teaching Certificate. After graduating, she taught in the Dearborn Public Schools prior to her marriage to Mervin O. Snider, Elkton, on June 24, 1950 at the Coldwater Methodist Church. He preceded her in death on September 16, 2013. Her teaching career in Huron County included Elkton Elementary and North Huron Schools, completing 15 years, before taking a position as a School Social Worker through the Huron Intermediate School District. She graduated from Michigan State University in 1963 with a Master of Arts Degree. Phyllis retired from HISD in 1984.
