
- Be sure to keep your cars locked.



### GREEN DOT PROGRAM

Have you ever been in a situation where you have seen or been aware of some kind of personal abuse and felt helpless and guilty about your lack of ability to help? The GREEN DOT is a world-wide program which works in collaboration with C.A.R.E. of Charlotte County.

Chris Hall of the Charlotte County **GREEN DOT PROGRAM** agreed to host a program in Oak Hollow if we get can a minimum of 15 people. The training is FREE, includes many varied group and individual activities so that the **six-hour session** goes by very quickly. A *free lunch* is included as are several take-home materials. The goal is to work together toward a shared ideal of a community without violence. They say, "Nobody has to do everything, but everyone can do something."
