Big Bike teams will consist of 3 riders.

Teams will be made up of one of the following options:

#### Note:

Vet "A" riders will be classified as Pro.

## **Scoring:**

3 total motos will be run; 2 by each team rider. Each team rider will race once with each of his teammates. Points will be based on 5 out of 6 moto scores. Each team will be allowed to drop their worst moto finish. The team with the lowest point total wins the event. Example:  $1^{st}$  place = 1 point,  $2^{nd}$  place = 2 points and so on.

#### MINI BIKE TEAM CHALLENGE

Mini Bike teams will consist of 3 riders and will be organized by bike size.

#### **MINI BIKE TEAMS**

#### 85cc TEAM

- Limit (1) Supermini or 12-15 rider per team

#### 65cc TEAM

- Limit (1) 10-11 yr old 65cc Rider per team

#### **50cc TEAM**

All 50cc teams must have (1) rider with a
10 in front wheel. No age restrictions apply.

### Additional info:

Riders will select their own teams. However, if there is any individual riders that do not designate a team we will select one for you.

## Scoring:

Each team member will race twice; depending on the participation, racing will consist of 2 or 3 motos. The number of motos will be determined at Rider's Meeting.

Each team will be scored based on their best 5 out of 6 finishes. The team with the lowest point total wins the event. Example:  $1^{st}$  place = 1 point,  $2^{nd}$  place = 2 points and so on.
