**BLACK GOSPEL AWARENESS (BGA) PROJECT TO HOLD AUDITIONS
ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 4 FROM 9A.M. TO 1 P.M.**

WHO:

Over 75 adults, teens and youth from Greater Trenton and throughout New Jersey will audition for a unique multicultural (All races; ALL religions) choir designed to promote diversity through gospel music that reaches across the lines of age, gender, race and religion.

WHAT:

The WIMG Community Advancement Fund's Black Gospel Awareness (BGA) Project aims to educate the community about diversity and break down stereotypes and barriers by utilizing gospel music and fellowship. A central component to the project is the formation of a community choir composed of individuals who have not previously had the opportunity to participate in black gospel singing. The choir will rehearse for approximately eight (8) total hours, over a 4-month period (excluding December), before performing a concert at the Princeton University Chapel on February 28, 2004 at 8P.M. during *Black History Month*.
