Christian Relief Fund (CRF)

Christian Relief Fund (CRF) was founded in 1971. Through the hands of many sponsors, it has supported thousands of children in over 30 countries. On their website, organizational founder, Baxter Loe, describes the heart-wrenching story of his trip to India, where he met and offered to provide assistance to a preacher named John Abraham. Before he could send any help, he found that John had died of starvation. This was his motivation for the creation of CRF and serves as only one example depicting the importance of this great work.

Christian Relief Fund has been working with Moses and the Nigerian program for about seven years. They currently sponsor 52 children and have 17 waiting for a sponsor. A sponsor sends \$35 each month and it helps a child go to school and have a meal while there. CRF tries to model the program after the Luke 2:52; to help the children grow as Christ grew in wisdom (education), physical growth, social development, and spiritual growth.
