Sinus Precautions

Due to the possible opening into the sinus, it is important that the following instructions are adhered to in order to aid in healing and closure of the sinus membrane.

- Do Not blow forceful air through the nose for the next week. Any sneezing should be done with an open mouth to relieve sinus pressure.
- If you were given a prescription for sinus medication, please follow the dosage directions.
