Helen Fuller, 91, of Kinde, died Wednesday, August 27, 2003, at Huron Medical Center in Bad Axe. She was born in Huron Township on September 26, 1911, daughter of the late George A. and Margaret (McDonald) Day. She was married to Frank Fuller on September 4, 1937 in Croswell.
