**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN,  
MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AUTHORIZING THE SALE  
OF A SNOW PLOW AND SALT SPREADER  
OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, ILLINOIS**

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities find that it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, to retain ownership of a used Western Pro snow plow and a Western Ice Breaker Hopper salt spreader; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities determine that it was in the best interests of the Village of Chapin to sell the personal property or use it as part of a trade-in.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the President and Board of Trustees find that the used Western Pro snow plow and Western Ice Breaker Hopper salt spreader now owned by the Village of Chapin, are no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interests of the Village will be served by their sale or trade-in.

**SECTION 2:** Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the Village President is hereby directed to take all necessary action to sell the snow plow and salt spreader or trade them in for other personal property needed by the Village.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
