Marriage of the Lamb Revelation 19:7–10 The marriage of the Lamb is the permanent union between Christ and the Church.

I. The Marriage of the Lamb has come.

Revelation 19:7 "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready."

- A. Marriage was the greatest celebration and social event of the Biblical culture. It contained three distinct stages:
 - 1. _____ It was usually arranged by both sets of parents in which they contracted the marriage of their children.
 - 2. _____ These festivities lasted up to a week and happen just before the actual ceremony.
 - **3.** _____ This is where the vows are exchanged.

II. The Church will be clothed in her righteousness.

Revelation 19:8 *"It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints."*

A. White linen clothing will represent their ____

- III. The wedding guest will be composed of all saints not composed of the church age.

Revelation 19:9 "Then he said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.' " And he said to me, "These are true words of God."

A. These Invitees will be:

- 1. Old Testament saints Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.
- 2. The Prophets, those on the wall of Faith (*Hebrews 11),* John the Baptist.
- B. Consummation of the Wedding can best be seen when the bridal city (______) comes down rest on the New Earth Revelation 21.
 - 1. Then all the righteous of all the ages will be invited to live there as well.
 - 2. Eventually all believers will be incorporated in that permanent, holy relationship with the Lord –

Revelation 21:3 — "³ And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them,"

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
