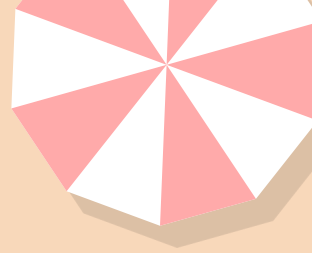

before the Lord, the King.



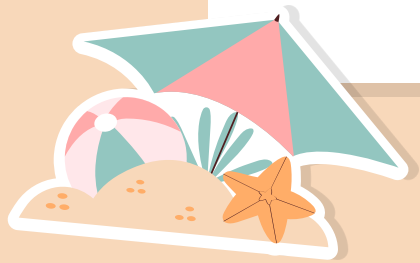
PRAYER OF CONFESSION

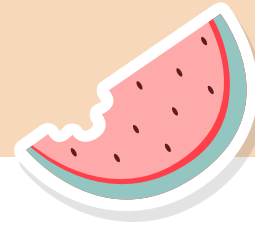

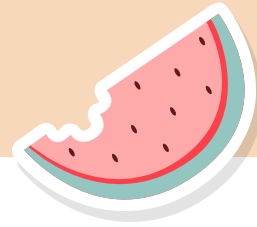
