CHARMED

The Community Housing Association for Rehabilitation Measures and Effective Development (CHARMED) is a non-profit agency located in Shawnee, Oklahoma, whose purpose is, in part, to promote development and rehabilitation of affordable housing with the counties of Seminole, Pottawatomie, Hughes, Payne, Lincoln, Pawnee, and Okfuskee.

From time to time, CHARMED receives grants from federal and state agencies that assist in preserving or constructing housing for low and moderate income persons. Applications from individuals are taken on a continuous basis from homeowners and assistance, when provided, is done so without regard to race, sex, national origin, color, religion, or handicap, or familial status.

It is the policy of CHARMED that all elements of the Fair Housing Act shall be adhered to by CHARMED, and CHARMED will not assist communities that have not adopted resolutions or ordinances explicitly stating that they will abide by the Act. The Fair Housing Act prohibits in the sale or rental of housing, certain discriminatory acts directed toward persons because of their race, color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status or handicap. CHARMED will assist individuals who believe they have been victims of unfair housing acts to file complaints with appropriate local, state, and federal officials.
