Please, **BE WATER WISE**

Protect your home from wildfire and conserve water.
Create a defensible space at least 100' around your home.



Zone 0 within 5 ft of home
Use rock, stone, inorganic mulch.
Remove firewood, garbage, furniture.
Remove leaves, twigs, branches.
Remove dry grass and dead plants.
Remove combustibles beneath decks.
Zone 1 within 30 ft of home
Repeat steps above.
Create fire & waterwise landscaping.
Zone 2 within 100 ft of home
Repeat steps above.

WATER - a precious resource in more ways than one.



To Reduce Smoke That Enters Your Home

Keep doors and windows closed

Switch HVAC from fresh air intake to recirculate mode

Evaporative coolers and window air conditioners can bring smoke inside. Close outdoor intake dampers.

Use portable air cleaners with high efficiency filters at the highest fan speed and often as possible.

Avoid Bring More Fine Particles Into Your Home

- Don't smoke
- Don't burn candles or incense
- Don't use aerosols
- Don't fry or broil food
- Don't vacuum unless your vacuum has a HEPA filter
