

**HOMER G.
FOGARSI**

Homer G. Fogarsi, 40, Colfax Township, died unexpectedly Wednesday, September 12 at his home following an apparent heart attack.

He was born July 1, 1939, at Detroit, son of Mrs. Della Fogarsi, Unionville, and the late Stephen Fogarsi.

Mr. Fogarsi and Marcia L. Mason were married Feb. 11, 1961, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Bad Axe.

The couple lived in Pigeon for 14 years and Alpena for five years, where they owned and operated the Fogarsi Kountry Korner's Party Store. The Fogarsis returned to the Bad Axe area one month ago.

He was employed at Huron Memorial Hospital, near Bad Axe, as a medical technician.

Mr. Fogarsi was a parishioner at St. John's Catholic Church, Alpena.

Surviving are his wife; his mother; three sons, Edward, Mark, and Richard Fogarsi, all living at home; one brother, Steve Fogarsi, Unionville; and several nieces and nephews.

A brother, Edward, preceded him in death.

Services were 11 a.m. Friday, Sept. 14 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church. The Rev. Charles W. Keho, pastor, officiated with burial in the church cemetery.
