



Silver Desert Spoon *Dasyliirion wheeleri*



Dasyliirion wheeleri is a drought-tolerant plant, native to northern Mexico and the southwestern United States. It is great when used as an accent or border in a water-wise landscape. Ours are fully headed in #15 containers. Dasyliirion is resistant to deer and rabbits, and is considered a part of the succulent family. It is very slow growing, and as it matures, will develop a short trunk. Once it is fully mature, it forms a tall flower spike that rises above the plant, and remains throughout the winter. It is a long living plant, and after several decades may grow multiple rosettes.
