

CAPTAIN GLEN WILLIAM
WILSON

Capt. Glen W. Wilson age 80 of 5847 Port Austin Rd., Caseville died Monday, July 11, at Lakeland Regional Medical Center, Lakeland, Fl.

He was born June 5, 1910, son of the late George and Abigail (Sullivan) Wilson in Laurium, where his grandfather, the late George Wilson Sr. was the first president of that town.

On January 30, 1954 he was united in marriage to Katherine Nadeau at the Ecorse Presbyterian Church.

At the age of 17 Mr. Wilson moved to the Detroit area. Shortly there after he joined the merchant marines and sailed the Great Lakes until he retired in 1973 as a captain and moved to the Caseville area in 1975.

He was a life member of the River Rouge Masonic Lodge # 511 F. & A. M., the Al Matta Grotto of Dearborn and a charter member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles #3690, Caseville.

Surviving are his wife, Katherine of Caseville and his sister, Helen Wilson of Houghton. A brother, George Wilson and two sisters, Leolo Wilson and Ruth Rova preceded him in death.
