"And at noon darkness covered the land." He was buried in a dark cave. God raised him before dawn, in the dark.

The theme of our biblical faith is that God comes to us where we are. And where we are is in the dark void of sin, death and evil. Actually, I was a bit misleading when I wrote above "we look for God in the darkness" – Rather it is God in Christ who seeks us out. That is the direction of salvation – from God to us through the Spirit of Jesus.

In this Lenten Season, stop what you're doing, stop looking elsewhere. Instead pause in the dark and silence and look around you, look close-by. God is there. Open your eyes and see that God is here in the darkness, comforting, encouraging, standing with.

CLC Recognized for Public Welcoming Statement

Mililani Hawaii, January 26, 2020

Christ Lutheran Church has been recognized by Reconciling Works (formerly Lutherans Concerned/North America) as the most recent Reconciling in Christ congregation in Hawaii. This recognition comes after the congregation officially adopted a public statement of welcome for people of all sexual orientations and gender identities. The statement reads as follows,

You are welcome at the table found at Christ Lutheran Church. Welcome to those of you who come bearing diverse gifts including wisdom regarding sexual orientations, gender identities and gender expressions. Welcome to all of you for your diverse colors, shapes, cultures, backgrounds, and traditions. Welcome to those of you born here and to those of you flown here. We seek to rejoice, grieve, heal and reconcile together as we gather around Jesus' table, which has been laid out for all.

The Reconciling in Christ recognition means that the congregation will be listed on a roster of congregations, organizations and synods in the United States and Canada, which publicly welcome members of all sexual orientations and gender identities.

Aubrey Thonvold, Executive Director of ReconcilingWorks, said "We welcome Christ Lutheran Church of Mililani, Hawaii to the Reconciling in Christ family. It is with love we are called to welcome all God's children into our congregations, communities, and our world. We thank Christ Lutheran for being an active member working for reconciliation and growth within the church so people of all sexual orientations and gender identities can share a lived experience of love, welcome, and family."

A Word About the Corona Virus and Church

As a former financial advisor and executive director of several social service organizations that dealt with particularly nasty viruses, let me share a word about what is going on and ways to stay safe.
