Round dancers in the VA, MD, WASCA and MDSDF areas, it's almost time to "*roule les bon temps*" at our VA State Convention this February 20-22, 2025 at the Virginia Beach-Norfolk Holiday Inn Hotel and Conference Center. We invite all our round dancing friends to "come on down" and enjoy dancing with many of your favorite VASCA round dance cuers. Join your dancing friends and share the excitement and pleasure of dancing with our outstanding cuer staff including;

There will be a separate round dance hall, with a cherry wood floor, that will provide about12 hours of phase II-IV dancing during the two afternoons and phase II-V dancing during the three evenings --Thursday February 20, Friday February 21 and Saturday February 22. There will also be 8 hours of 2x2 round and square dancing at the 2025 VA State Convention. With more than 200 round dances programmed throughout the convention, you will have plenty of choices to enjoy old favorites and new dancing challenges.

Our evening round dance program will include a showcase on Thursday evening for the 7 dance teaches to be presented during the convention, a "cuerama' to kick-off the round dancing on Thursday evening, a diehard session on Friday and a special final hour on Saturday featuring all cuers and all 7 dances taught at the Convention. We've attached the individual hourly dance program for both the round dance and 2x2 halls and an alphabetic list of the individual dances to help everyone plan their activities during the convention.

During the morning and afternoon on Friday and Saturday, we will teach 7 round dances covering a range of rhythms. We will also have several clinics/workshops to help dancers review specific figures in the dances and their rhythms being taught.

On Friday we will have the following teaches:

Phase IV+2 – Foxtrot [Hopper] – *Must Be Believed to Be Seen* Phase IV Cha [Eum] – [dance not yet completed] Phase IV+2 Bolero [Ryder] – *The Twelfth of Never* Phase IV Rumba [Crofford] – *Venus in Blue Jeans*

On Saturday, we will have the following teaches: Phase III+2 Foxtrot [Ryder] – *Wonderful Wonderful* Phase IV Cha [Bloxom] – *Dance the Night IV* Phase III+2 Waltz [Hopper] – *Open Arms III*

There will also be an Introduction to Round Dancing on Friday afternoon to entice more dancers to "get down" and enjoy our special form of a "social contact sport". Dancers can expect 13 hours of these special dance activities to fill their Friday and Saturday mornings and afternoons.

With all of these exceptionally exciting dancing opportunities, you can't afford to miss your chance to "let the good times roll" at our VA State Convention this February in VA Beach. All of us look forward to seeing and dancing with everyone who can join us.

Do your part! Make sure you are dancing as accurately as possible. We all know it is help-ful when others are in the correct position so do your best to be there for your students!
 Allow the caller to be the teacher, they are the professionals. They will provide instruction

so that is off of your plate!

3. Stay quiet. Whether dancing or sitting out taking a break do your best to not create distractions for your new dancers! Learning new things requires concentration

Be a friendly face and encourage the new students! This is a shared fun activity. We want new students to enjoy themselves and feel they are part of the club!





2 exhibition groups to put unique dance styles on display at the 74th NSDC

We know you will have a lot of opportunities for various types of dancing, workshops, and education classes while attending the 74th National Square Dance Convention® in Shreveport, LA, on June 25-28, 2025, but when you need a break or just to rest your feet come on over to the Shreveport Convention Center's Auditorium (Exhibit Hall 2) and watch the exhibition groups perform their routines. You will be treated to the unique dances of two groups, each putting their distinctive style of dancing on display - the California Heritage Dancers and River City Riders. The 74th NSDC's exhibition groups will be performing Thursday, June 26, and Friday, June 27. See the convention's daily schedules upon arrival for each performance group's days and times.

CALIFORNIA HERITAGE DANCERS

The California Heritage Dancers exhibition group anticipates doing three performances/programs at the 74th NSDC. One will be an hour-long program on the History of Square Dancing, another will be a historically accurate dance from the 1800s, and the third will be a dance specially adapted to fit the "Dance on the Wild Side" theme of the convention.

The California Heritage Dancers exhibition group has been performing since 1987; they will celebrate their 38th anniversary in October 2025. Their



performance venues have included more than 25 National Square Dance Conventions[®], three Canadian Square Dance Festivals, many California State Square Dance Conventions, regional festivals, community events, and even a two-week performance tour in Austria. The dance troupe's purpose is to educate as well as entertain. By demonstrating the history of square dancing from its beginning here in the United States in the 1700s to modern times (1950s), they



The California Heritage Dancers exhibition group demonstrates ones of their many routines not just for entertainment, but to also educate the public and to provide cultural awareness. hope to ignite in their audiences an appreciation of our national folk dance, according to group dance leaders.

Ruth Walker-Hagan, founder and original director, created the California Heritage Dancers to bring the square dance cultural heritage to the attention of the American public. Extensive research (pre-internet) has resulted in a series of dances performed with authentic period costuming, music, figures, and customs of the era. The ever-expanding repertoire currently includes 10 core routines plus multiple adaptations and variations dating from the Colonial period up through the 1950s.

The dance troupe is dedicated to preserving the historic dances which have contributed to the worldwide movement of square dancing. This dance as we know it today originated in the United States, and like the people who have contributed to its development, is a product of the cultural "melting pot" which makes

RIVER CITY RIDERS

The River City Riders (RCR) have galloped their way into your hearts at 12 national conventions, nine USA West Conventions, local festivals and many other events. According to lead riders, Jolene and Ed Cummings, the Oregon-based group originally formed in 2000 but were "corralled" for awhile before reorganizing in 2006. "Our club at that time was the River City Dancers. They put the idea together from what they saw at a county fair in Washington. Some guys with "horses" strapped on them were circulating

among the crowd. They went home and decided they could do this and perform with square dance moves!"

The caller for the River City Dancers in Milwaukie, OR, at that time was Les Seely, and he and wife, Paula, who now reside in Arizona, helped in the creation of the River City Riders. Five years ago, the reins of the organization were picked up by a new sponsor, the Country Cut-Ups located at the "Barn" the Country in Boring, OR.

The late Jim Hattrick served as a long-time group caller and created several programs over the course of 12 years, including a six-couple "Hex" routine, a four-couple dance sequence with A-1 moves called "Long Tall Texan," and the group's three-couple "Triride" that features six different music patterns.

"Each program has moves that fit together like a glove," Jolene Cummings noted. "Jim was a genius that shared his knowledge. We're so sad that he passed away in 2023, he is greatly missed, but the group continues to celebrate his life with each performance."

The River City Riders exhibition group now has a new caller standing by, to be announced soon, for the 74th NSDC. The horses will be making the long journey from Oregon to Shreveport via a special trailer pulled by the Cummings, along with a few fellow riders as passengers. The group's sturdy steeds are made from plastic barrels decorated by their riders to look like horses that the dancers step into and then hook onto a belt he or she is wearing. The horses can weigh between 25

to 30 pounds! These steeds have awesome riders that add their expertise to the program, including the RCR's lead riders, Jolene and Ed Cummings on Twilight and Mr. Ed, and then Danny and Carol Williamson riding Freedom and Hayburner, Young and Robert Lumsden on Callus and Choco, Ron Rasmussen riding Butterscotch and Lois Manos on Cocoa.

To fund the program, the group conducts garage sales, performs for Senior Citizen Centers and Square Dance Clubs, and accepts donations. Jolene Cummings said the money raised by the group goes toward transportation for the horses and the riders pay their own way.

"We look at it like it's our vacation," she stated. "So our fellow dancers, friends, and club members help finance this "horse" program and move the horses across the country for the 'trail rides.' It's pretty awesome!"

One of the group's fun adventures on a previous "trail ride" was a stop in the Four Corners area where four states touch on the way to New Mexico. "The horses felt like galloping, so of course they did!" Ed Cummings added over the past 14 years the horses have traveled more than 70,000 miles, including all the way from Oregon to Georgia, performing for various conventions, clubs and events.


