To this end, we spearheaded the opposition to the proposed 260-lot development in Painted Hills, successfully protested a proposed electronic sign for the International Wildlife Museum that was not in keeping with our rural neighborhood and pitched in to help repaint and restore Camp Cooper buildings and ramadas. As a member, you will receive emails about current neighborhood events as well as forwarded correspondence from various environmental groups.

Additionally, members gather on sunny Saturday mornings in Spring and Fall to pick up litter and debris from alongside Camino de Oeste (from Ironwood Hill Road to Gates Pass Road) as part of the Adopt-A-Highway program. We have also adopted Feliz Paseos Park. Bi-annual road clean-ups are followed by a potluck brunch and general meeting at a member's home.
