Coronavirus (COVID-19) and your visit to Prince Albert National Park

The health and safety of Canadians, visitors and Parks Canada team members is our top priority.

We are following the advice of public health experts and taking steps to support the Government of Canada's efforts to limit the spread of COVID-19 and reduce risks to visitors, employees, and other users of Parks Canada spaces.

Effective 12:01 a.m. on Wednesday, March 25, 2020, Parks Canada is temporarily suspending all visitor services and motor vehicle access by visitors until further notice. We will limit activities to basic critical operations.

Parks Canada will re-evaluate the temporary closure on an ongoing basis and keep you updated as more information becomes available. Please check the Parks Canada national information portal dedicated to COVID-19 for updates.

The latest information you need to know about your visit to Prince Albert National Park

The information below, specific to Prince Albert National Park is currently being updated given the most recent closures. Please check back soon.

While visitor services and motor vehicle access are temporarily suspended, Parks Canada will continue to deliver a number of critical functions. In Prince Albert National Park these include:

- Highway management and snow removal
- Fire response
- Law Enforcement
- Water and waste treatment
- Visitor safety

Waskesiu Townsite

Waskesiu townsite is open. Cottage and cabin owners are able to access and stay at their properties beginning April 1, 2020, as per their leases.

Facilities that are closed in Prince Albert National Park

- The Visitor Centre
- Park Entrance Gate Kiosks
- All washroom facilities including outhouses at day-use areas
- Camping facilities, including backcountry camping, are closed until further notice.
