

Student AGREEMENT TO COMPLETE DAILY HEALTH CHECK - STUDENT

This form indicates the family's agreement to assess their child(ren) for symptoms and to ensure their child does not attend school if they have symptoms or answer yes to any of the following screening questions.

During the 2020-2021 school year, parents/guardians and caregivers must assess their child(ren) daily for symptoms of common cold, influenza, COVID-19, or other infectious respiratory disease before sending them to school.

If a child has any symptoms, they must not go to school. Students who experience seasonal allergies or other COVID-19-like symptoms that are related to an existing condition can continue to attend school when they are experiencing these symptoms as normal. If they experience any change in symptoms, they should seek assessment by a health care provider.

Students still attend school if a member of their household has cold, influenza, or COVID-19-like symptoms, provided the student/staff is asymptomatic. It is expected that the symptomatic household member is seeking assessment by a health care provider.

Have you been ill or had have any symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 24 hours:

Fever

Chills

Cough or worsening of chronic cough

Shortness of breath

Sore throat

Runny nose / stuffy nose

Loss of sense of smell or taste

Headache

Fatigue

Diarrhea

Loss of appetite

Nausea and vomiting

Muscle aches

Conjunctivitis (pink eye)

Dizziness, confusion
Abdominal pain
Skin rashes or discoloration of fingers or toes

Has your child or anyone in your household returned from travel outside Canada in the last 14 days?

Is your child or is anyone in your household a confirmed contact of a person confirmed to have COVID-19?

- Check BCCDC's Symptoms of COVID-19 regularly to ensure the list is up to date.

If you answer yes to any of the above questions, you must stay home.

If you are experiencing any symptoms of illness, contact a health care provider for further assessment. This includes 8-1-1, or a primary care provider like a physician or nurse practitioner.

If you answered "YES" to any question, use the COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool <https://bc.thrive.health/> to determine if you should be tested for COVID-19.

You must immediately contact your principal and provide any information or direction given by public health.

Our staff will monitor all children for symptoms throughout the day. If a child develops symptoms while at school, parents/ guardians will be contacted to pick the child up and take them home until symptoms have passed.

If the symptoms get worse, parents/guardians should contact their physician or call 811 for further instructions.

The school district will continue to follow all guidelines from the Ministry of Education and the Provincial Health Officer.

We will continue to ask that caregivers do not enter the school without making a prior appointment with the principal.
