#### A Moment In Time By Rodger Whisman

I'll open with these two Scriptures ... Psalm 39:4, "LORD, make me to know mine end, and the measure of my days, what it is; that I may know how frail I am." And James 4:14, "Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away."

So again I say, "What does God have to do with this?" And I remain always, "EVERYTHING!"

#### "That in every thing ye are enriched by Him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge ...." (1 Corinthians 1:5)

Recently I've confronted a new challenge. I found within this challenge that I was dealing with time itself as an important consideration. That is, leaning toward a new understanding of the time I have been blessed with on earth and being patient with God as He works out the process with me. "In your pathance passass yo your souls," (Luke 21:19) The NIV translates the same verse like this, "Stand thm, and your will with the mass 5:3-4 we read, "And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; And patience, experience; and experience, hope ..." Even Solomon in the great wisdom God gave him wrote much on times and seasons such as Ecclesiastes 3:1, "To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven." (Read on through Ecclesiastes 3:2-8) I want to stay on point but I will share a bonus at the end of this on one of my challenges that became apparent, but was tucked away in a hidden corner of my heart and mind.

When God blessed mankind with life He also blessed him with time. A time to grow, to learn, to experience, to mature and a time to process all of the above. So we were given 'time' to make choices and freely decide for ourselves. *Ecclesiastes 3:17* reminds us of this, *"I said in mine heart, God shall judge the righteous and the wicked: for there is a time there for every purpose and for every work."* 

In our youth time is not considered, as we take for granted that there is much of it at hand. As we begin to grow older and age we begin to realize that there is not as much time as we originally thought. Let's read *Romans 13:11, "And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed."* What I too have begun to realize and grasp is the importance and significance of our time on earth. And all of what we do here on earth is our allotted time and it is of greater significance than I had led myself to believe previously. *Ephesians 5:15-16* says, "See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, Redeeming the time, because the days are evil." Listen now how the NLT shares *Romans 5:15-16, "So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days."* 

The Scriptures in diverse verses even state clearly that we ARE foreknown. Our existence is there, foreknown of and by the Father. And if foreknown and that IN Christ the Father has a purpose AND a plan for our lives. That makes us born with purpose and intent. WOW!! This is what *Romans 8:28-30* tells us, "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose. For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified."

So yes, God most definitely has a divine purpose for each of our lives, for those that have chosen freely to accept and walk for God. The offer of Salvation is for ALL men, as *Titus 2:11* reads, "For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men," Now let's read 2 Peter 3:9, "The LORD is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." In laymen's terms; His love is so great for you, His intent so clear that He has made a blueprint ahead of time for each of our lives, for this time and this season. What I mean is this, YOU are part of a far greater plan that He has already drawn up AND has begun to finish the work/workmanship of that plan. When you begin to fulfill His purpose and intent for you, you also begin to be totally fulfilled in your heart, mind and life. God also expresses His desire, that you are wanted and loved in the Kingdom of Heaven.

Yes! He loved you first and put His purpose and intent, for this time and season, within you. He even confirms this in Jeremiah 29:11-12, "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Then shall ye call upon Me, and ye shall go and pray unto Me, and I will hearken unto you."

Maybe at this point in your life you think that your time has passed. You've messed up too much, or just plain blown it and/or think you have lost your chance and opportunity to recover that time. REALLY? First let me say this, when you come to Christ, the word chance does NOT exist. Salvation has NOTHING to do with chance. Salvation is God's GIFT of opportunity and restoration is one of God's specialties. You can pick nearly anywhere in the Bible and see God's hand of

restoration. You could read the Book of Job or how about David throughout the Book of Psalms and yes, even Saul in the Book of Acts, where through God's restoration process Saul was redeemed and renamed as Paul, the Apostle Paul. Paul went on to write nearly 2/3 of the New Testament. How about that!?! Secondly, you truly don't think that ... do you? Have you even stopped to consider that the Father that see's ALL is in NO WAY suddenly taken by surprise of what you have already done OR will ever do, your placement or misplacement or your present circumstances catch Him off guard?? Let's examine the Scriptures, Old and New.

Romans 11:29 tells us, "For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance." Listen here as the Message translation states Romans 11:29, "God's gifts and God's call are under FULL warranty - NEVER cancelled, NEVER rescinded." My dear friends, our Father in heaven finishes EVERYTHING He has ever began! You are a work of God's and His plan is to finish that work in you. And watch this, YOU get to choose to allow Him to be a part of your life! That my friends is called 'free choice'! YOU choose. What does the Bible say about this?

Deuteronomy 30:19 reads, "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live ..." This Scripture gives you two views to consider, for this day and this time. Let me offer a third opportunity to consider or reconsider.

There are many attributes to God our Father. Several of whom He alone is, and several of whom He is to you personally. Allow me to introduce 'EI-Roi' to your studies. This is just one of the many names/attributes of God which simply put translates, "The God that see's ALL". He has seen every single aspect of your life. Yes, NOW in this immediate time. There are NO surprises to Him and definitely NO private interpretations or so called, secrets to life with Him. He, yes the same God, our God, is Omnipresent. Which means, "ALL in all, present EVERYWHERE at the same time!"

As you step forward today you may say, "Okay, I got that! What am I supposed to do in my present circumstances, life IN Christ and through Christ?" Let me begin by saying this, "God IS above ALL of your circumstances!" Your job, should you choose to accept it, is to reflect the very divine nature of whom God is, the Christ IN you, the very hope of glory. Or, this is a simpler view. You/we are to be a representation of the Kingdom of God, NOT a salesperson of spiritual real-estate. You/we are to be a reflection to others of whom Christ is, in you. In other words, you are here to allow/let the Gospel of Christ shine through you. God's purpose for you comes through you to others offering an abundant life, that being IN Christ. Let's look at 2 Corinthians 9:12, "And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me." And now, 2 Corinthians 8:14, "But by an equality, that now at this time your abundance may be a supply for their want, that their abundance also may be a supply for your want: that there may be equality." This is the way the NIV translates 2 Corinthians 8:14, "At the present time your plenty will supply what they need, so that in turn their plenty will supply what you need. The goal is equality."

Be very clear of this, Christ came to do away with our sins, and in due time, do away with sin itself! NOT merely cover them up! Christ set us free for the purpose and intent to in turn help set others free through the Christ IN you/us! To me, that sounds VERY significant, as we ALL are here at this appointed time and season to be totally purpose driven.

Let's step further forward, to John 4:2-3, where Jesus Himself said this, "In IDy Fathar's house are many manatons: If It ware not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you wite Myself; that where I am, there yo may be also ...," God's Son, our Christ, after being resurrected by the Father and having been received in His heavenly placement just told us, His NEW brothers and sisters, "Hey, it's okay. I've gone ahead of you to prepare a place for you in the Kingdom of Heaven." But that's not all.

In John 14:16-18, Jesus still, promises us this, "And I will pray the Pather, and He shall give you another Combuter, that He may abide with you forever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world eannot receive, because it seeth Him not, notifier knoweth Him: but yo know Him; for He dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you." In the NIV translation the worl 'comfortless' is translated 'as orphans'. What does Jesus mean when He says "... and He shall give you ANOTHER Comforters' I love how the Word of God explains and is confirmed by Itself, when we read on further. So let's read on, in John 14:25-27, "These things have I spaken unto you, being yet present with you. But the Comforter, which is the Hely Chost, whom the Pather will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. Peace I leave with you, Bly peace I give unto your not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, notifier let it be afraid."

So here's what's going on in your time and in your season, right NOW and right here on this earth today. Christ sent us a Helper, a Comforter, a Teacher and a Personage to walk through ALL of this life with us and by our side which is the Holy Spirit/Holy Ghost. He is also known as our Guide and our Counselor. So when did the Holy Spirit come? Watch and listen as we walk together to see.

Fixing our Thoughts - Psalm 77 By M.D.

I'm sending along something that I've been inspired to write. These words truly reflect some of the answers that I have found lately. I hope everyone likes it but more importantly pray that it touch the hearts of the brothers and sisters that read it and are getting caught up in their thoughts as I have. Especially those locked away in a cell by themselves, as I too am.

Although I have had some recent correspondence from the courts it's only to let me know that they are investigating my appeal. With that said, I would greatly appreciate all of the prayers that I can get concerning my appeal. Of course I am praying that the Lord will take away this life sentence hanging over my head right now. In this cell 24/7 I'm with my Lord all the time searching for the answers I need to move on. Here is what has been revealed to me.

No doubt, I can understand where Asaph the psalmist was coming from when he wrote in *Psalm 77:4*, "You had my eyelids open; I am so troubled I cannot speak." I've spent many sleepless nights, tossing and turning in bed, considering solution after solution for my dilemma, evaluating every little thing. Though my body is completely weary, and what I need most is rest, I just can't shut my eyes. Because of the heaviness of exhaustion and helplessness, my lips are silent, but my tormented spirit is quietly calling out, "Oh my Lord God, I don't know what to do!"

Yet, please understand overcomers, just as a shot of dope has NEVER helped anything, analyzing your plight over and over again will never help your troubled souls. Rather you MUST redirect your focus.

Asaph wrote, "I call to remembrance my song in the night; I meditate within my heart, and my spirit makes diligent search. I will remember the years of the right hand of the Most High." (Psalm 77:6,10)

The only thing that will heal you and help you rest is to turn your thoughts to the faithfulness of God. That is why Paul wrote, "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your HEARTS and MINDS through Christ Jesus. Finally brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue, and if there is anything praiseworthy - meditate on these things." (Philippians 4:6-8)

Here, our brother Paul offers us the blueprint for ending the sleepless nights. First, we pray out our anxieties - discuss your troubles with God and then give them to Him. It is difficult and it takes ALL of our self-will but you MUST change the focus of your mind to the God who will surely help you OVERCOME every dilemma. Then you will find that it's true, "He gives to His beloved sheep." (Psalm 127:2)

I'm coming up on five years in prison and for 90 days I've been awaiting a reply from the appeals court on my motions for a hearing in my case in which I have been fighting the whole time. God has been giving me insight to so much I never knew. This is the hearing I've been asking for since this all started five years ago and this is the first time I wasn't denied or responded to within 15 days of filing my motions of request. Hebrews 4:16 says, "So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most." But we must all remember in doing so, in Hebrews 11:6, "And it is impossible to please God without faith."

Anyone who wants to come to Him must believe that God exists and that He rewards those who sincerely seek Him. Our pastor has said, "Don't work for what you can't keep! Live for the thing you can't lose." Remember Luke 17:6, "The Lord answered, "If you had faith even as small as a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, "May you be uprooted and be planted in the seq," and it would abey you?" Faith is everything. Read Matthew 15:28, "Dear woman," Jesus said to her, "your faith is great. Your request is granted." And her daughter was instantly healed." ### Foot's Bible Study Rotes

#### 2 Chronicles 31:1-33:13

Why was idol worship so bad? The Israelites had access to the one true God, but they constantly fell into worshipping lifeless idols made of wood or stone. They put aside worshiping the Creator in order to worship the creation. We are just as guilty when God no longer holds first place in our life. When we think more about wealth, pleasure, prestige, or material possessions than about God, we are actually worshipping them as gods. Because of idol worship, the people of Judah were eventually sent into captivity in foreign lands. (36:14-17) We may not be sent into captivity, but discipline awaits all those who continually put earthly desires above spiritual priorities. (31:1)

When Hezekiah was confronted with the frightening prospect of an Assyrian invasion, he made two important decisions. He did everything he could to deal with the situation, and he trusted God for the outcome. That is exactly what we must do when faced with difficult or frightening situations. Take all the steps you possibly can to solve the problem or improve the situation. But also commit the situation to God in prayer, trust Him for the solution. (32:1)

In a list of corrupt kings, Manasseh would rank near the top. His life was a catalog of evil deeds, including idol worship, sacrificing his own children, and temple desecration. Eventually, however, he realized his sins and cried out to God for forgiveness, and God listened. If God can forgive Manasseh, surely He can forgive anyone. Are you burdened by overpowering guilt? Do you doubt that anyone could forgive what you have done? Take heart, until death, no one is beyond the reach of God's forgiveness. (33:12-13)

#### Romans 15:1-22

The knowledge of the Scriptures affects our attitudes toward the present and the future. The more we know about what God has done in years past, the greater the confidence we have about what He will do in the days ahead. We need to diligently read our Bibles so we may have confidence that God's will is best for us. (15:4)

#### Psalm 25:1-22

We are bombarded daily with relentless appeals to go in various directions. Television advertising alone places hundreds of options before us, in addition to appeals made by political parties, cults, false religions, and dozens of other groups. Numerous organizations, including Christian organizations, seek to motivate us to support a cause. Add to that the dozens of decisions we must make concerning our job, our family, our money, and our society and we become desperate for someone to show us the right way. If you find yourself pulled in several directions, remember that God teaches the humble His way. (25:8-11)

If ever two powerful forces were needed to preserve us along life's way, they are integrity and honesty. The psalmist asks for these to protect him step by step. Honesty makes us learn God's requirements and strive to fulfill them. Integrity being what we say we are, keeps us from claiming to be honest while living as if we do not know God. Honesty says, "This is the shepherd's way." Integrity says, "I will walk constantly in it." (25:21)

#### Proverbs 20:15-18

This verse is not a command on the morality of wealth, but a statement about the comparative value of wisdom and money. Wisdom is simply worth more. Thus, being poor and wise is more precious than being rich and foolish. (20:15)

This Proverb is a maxim (general truth or rule of conduct) that moves from the lesser to the greater. We should always think before we act, and serious matters like war require a maximum of forethought. (20:18)

Hey ya'll, just been rolling through *Ephesians* 4 where Paul begins with, "*Therefore, I, a prisoner* for serving the Lord." Are we too being prisoners for serving the Lord? According to God, there are only two religions Jesus and anti-Jesus. We were all chosen to be Christ's representatives here on earth. Yet we all know being a Christian is the hardest thing you'll ever do, which is why we need to remember God chose us all to be something and continue to be who we are as we do what God wants us to do. Remember that our oneness, IN Christ, does not destroy our individuality and that

we can be holy because Jesus said we could be holy. If we give in, we'll always go back but Jesus can move us beyond that. Love to ya'll short and tall. Vaya con Dios!! Don't ride faster than your angels can fly.

In Acts 1:4-8, Luke recorded these accounts, "On one occasion, while He was eating with them, He gave them this command." (Acts 1:4a) Let's stop right here for a second. It's important to know and remember that at this immediate setting Jesus had already gone to the Cross, been crucified, went to the grave where He defeated satan, took BACK the keys to the Kingdom and having ALL the authority He then rose again on the third day (Colossians 2:15, "And having disarmed the powers and authorities, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross."). Jesus had now been walking with them (this side of the Cross) for 40 more days and they were all now sitting together eating when Jesus gave them these instructions. "Do not leave Jarusalam, but wait for the gift bly Father promised, which you have heard life speak about. For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Hely Sattl." (Acts 1:4b-5) "Then they gathered around him and asked him, 'LORD, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" (Acts 1:6) Obviously they didn't fully understand what was just about to happen. Jesus was about to leave this earth and ascend into heaven and receive His seat at the right hand of the Father. Listen as Jesus tells them, "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Pather has set by His own anthority. But you will receive pewer when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judee and Samarta, and to the ends of the earth." (Acts 1:7-8) What powerful promises! The Scriptures are full of promises and dispersions of the POWER and intent of the Holy Spirit on our behalf. Second Corinthians 1:20 tells us, "For all the promises of God IN Him are yea, and IN Him Amen, unto the glory of God by us."

Maybe you're asking, "But what about my situation, the circumstances, the present overwhelming odds and how hard I condemn myself for my errors?" Please consider and receive comfort through these words in *Romans 8:38-39*, "For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is IN Christ Jesus our Lord." So you are greatly loved and were designed with great purpose. With all that I have shared and that with Scriptures; at this time and hour the choice remains yours! I promised you all a bonus at the end of this share. Here it is.

Those that truly know me know that fear is no issue with me, or so I too thought. At a Veteran's (Christian) meeting we spoke on FEAR. Not in combat. Not in our return and attempt at adjustment to the civilian life. Ready? But the fear that each of us carried of God, of serving God, of failing God in our calling and especially a fear of what God's choices were for each of us in our responsible positions of ministry. We found not one but two fears predominate:

1) Old Testament; the very fear of God Himself.

2) New Testament fear of God; this kind of fear covers mostly respect, reverence and a soft humble heart for Him so He can touch our hearts AND we can touch His heart!!

WOW! This is our conclusion and acronym for F.E.A.R. - False, Evidence (that), Appears, Real. Our fear was our proof that we lacked greatly in simply 'Trusting God' with His plans for our lives.

I pray that what I've shared here steer you, through my own challenges which were no more than a false illusion at an attempt to hinder my walk with my Father. God: guide these words.

#### God's Grace is Available to All By Maria Gonzales

God's Grace is for everybody, no matter who you are and no matter what you've done, God loves you, and He wants you to come home to Him. He wants to shower His grace on you; He wants to throw a party for you when you return. The Bible says in *Romans 4:16*, *"The promise is not only for those people that live under the Law of Moses. It is for anyone who lives with faith like Abraham who are the people who "live under the Law of Moses."* The Jewish people, the nation of Israel lived under the Law of Moses in the Old Testament. This verse is saying that God's grace is available not just to the Jews who lived under the Law of Moses; it is available to everybody with faith. That's good news! God's grace is not just for the Jewish people, it's for all of us. All of us can come to God in the same way, through faith in the grace of God through His Son, Jesus Christ.

Hello to all of my Overconces for Efrist family everywhere! This may be a rather lengthy praise report BUT He is always worthy of our praise, Amen?!

First off, like I said, I want to give all glory to God for everything I'm about to share. God has blessed me in so many ways. I know it's been awhile since I last wrote to the Stat family, but I want to say that I have not forgotten all of you. In fact you all are always in my prayers. I'm always sharing with others what you all do there for all of us here in prison and sharing the newsletters. Here is my praise report.

When I first came down I had to go to a 3 yard only because of an out of state warrant that placed a hold on me. I didn't know how I was going to do it but I had to find a way to send all of my paperwork forms to have the hold released and the warrant dropped. And that was only if they wanted to due to the fact that I also had 3 years probation left in California. So I sent a letter to my probation in California to see if they would work with me before having to send all of those forms to the courts there.

Well, before I knew it probation sent me a form to inform me NOT to send any paperwork to the courts there. They said that they did it all for me and told the Judge that they would be dropping me from probation. Therefore, leaving me clean of any pending charges, warrants or probation in California. Thank God!! And all of this without me having to do anything but 'believe that all things are possible through God who gives us the strength.' Before all of this I had only one release date in 2019. All of this time I have continued telling my wife and kids that I am coming home in 2018 just to try and keep their spirits up. I kept telling them all to trust in God as I'm doing and you all will see His blessings.

Well, I have now been moved to a 2 yard. That's a blessing and here's another blessing. Only four days on this yard with no job and once again God did what He will always do on His time and terms. He got me a job! And not just any job. I am now working as a structural firefighter and going through all of the tests. It's a dream I once had when I was a volunteer firefighter. I remember I wanted to become full time, save lives and help others.

I also have a new release date just like I trusted and believed God would give me at the proper time. I go home just like I told my kids to believe, in 2018! AMEN!! I'm sharing this NOT to brag about anything that I have done. I'm sharing this with everyone to encourage someone to surrender your life to God and trust the Lord to do right for you. Trust is all we are required to do because He has already supplied the promise to us as long as we allow Him to do His will and not ours.

Have I struggled at times? Yes! I am just like everyone else. But when I do find myself trying to take back control of my own life I quickly remember what Paul said in *Philippians 4:7-9* (ERV), "And God's peace will stand guard over all your thoughts and feelings. His peace can do this far better than our human minds. Brothers and sisters, continue to think about what is good and worthy of praise. Think about what is true and honorable and right and pure and respected. And do what you learned and received from me - what I told you and what you saw me do. And the God that gives peace will be with you." TRUST THE LORD, AMEN!!?!!

All of this started to take root in me from a seed that brother Wade, his wife, kids and family planted in me when I was in the county jail. Wade used to come and do one on one Bible studies with me there back in 2014. I thank all of you from the bottom of my heart. You all are my family and soon we will find each other on the 'outside' serving the Lord there together. - **B.P.**

#### Columbus Day Trivia: 9 Facts You May Not Know about This National Holiday!

Columbus Day is a national holiday in many countries in the Americas and elsewhere which officially celebrates the anniversary of Christopher Columbus' arrival in the Americas on October 12, 1492.

1. The landing is celebrated as "Columbus Day" in the United States, as "Día de la Raza" ("Day of the Race") in many countries in Latin America and as "Día de la Hispanidad" and "Fiesta Nacional" in Spain, where it is also the religious festivity of la Virgen del Pilar.

2. It is also celebrated as Día de las Américas (Day of the Americas) in Belize and Uruguay, as Discovery Day in the Bahamas, as Día del Respeto a la Diversidad Cultural (Day of Respect for Cultural Diversity) in Argentina and as Giornata Nazionale di Cristoforo Colombo or Festa Nazionale di Cristoforo Colombo in Italy and in the Little Italy's around the world.

 These holidays have been celebrated unofficially since the late 18th century and officially in various countries since the early 20th century.

 Columbus Day first became an official state holiday in Colorado in 1906, and became a federal holiday in the United States in 1937, though people have celebrated Columbus's voyage since the colonial period.

 In 1792, New York City and other U.S. cities celebrated the 300th anniversary of his landing in the New World. President Benjamin Harrison called upon the people of the United States to celebrate Columbus Day on the 400th anniversary of the event.

6. During the four hundredth anniversary in 1892, teachers, preachers, poets and politicians used Columbus Day rituals to teach ideals of patriotism. These patriotic rituals took themes such as citizenship boundaries, the importance of loyalty to the nation, and celebrating social progress.

 Many Italian-Americans observe Columbus Day as a celebration of their heritage, the first occasion being in New York City on October 12, 1866.

 Since 1970 (Oct. 12), the holiday has been fixed to the second Monday in October, coincidentally exactly the same day as Thanksgiving in neighboring Canada fixed it since 1959.

9. The traditional date of the holiday also adjoins the anniversary of the United States Navy (founded October 13, 1775), and thus both occasions are customarily observed by the Navy (and usually the Marine Corps as well) with either a 72- or 96-hour liberty period.
