Gary A. Engelhardt, 53 of Sebawaing, died Tuesday morning, Oct. 4, at his home following a seven-year illness.

He was born in Kilmanagh on April 14, 1941, the son of Elsie C. (Bernhardt) Engelhardt of Sebawaing and Arnold "Buzz" Engelhardt of Kilmanagh.

Mr. Engelhardt was a 1958 graduate of Sebawaing High School. He had attended Midwest Blacksmith School in Xenia, OH, and had been employed at Northville downs Race Track for several years where he shod horses before retiring seven years ago due to ill health. He had lived in South Lyon before moving to Sebawaing in 1987.

Surviving are one son, Mickey A. Engelhardt of Canton, one daughter, Annette Winner of Yoder, PA, his parents, Elsie Engelhardt of Sebawaing, his father and stepmother, Arnold "Buzz" and Ruby Engelhardt of Kilmanagh, one brother and sister-in-law, Dennis J. and Sharon Engelhardt of Gageton, one sister and brother-in-law, Elaine and James Widman of Sebawaing, and several aunts, uncles, nieces and nephews.

One brother, Duane Engelhardt, preceded him in death in May, 1976.

The funeral took place Thursday afternoon, Oct. 6, in Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawaing. Rev. Jeffrey Walsh of Kilmanagh officiated and burial was in St. John Lutheran Cemetery, Sebawaing.
