

THOMAS JECKELL

1917 - 1985

Services were conducted Monday, Aug. 12 for Thomas H. Jeckell, age 68, of Bay Port, who passed away unexpectedly on Friday, Aug. 9 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon.

He was born Jan. 10, 1917 in Port Huron, son of the late Tom and Beatrice (Winslade) Jeckell. He married Phyllis Forge on Nov. 30, 1941 in Bay Port. He was employed by the Forest Division of the Flint Recreation and Park Board for 33 years before retiring in 1974 and moving to Bay Port. He served in the U.S. Army in Europe during World War II and earned a Bronze Star. He was a member of the Flint City Employees Club.

He was preceded in death by one sister, Helen Hazel.
