Current RM Cluster Priorities:

- Given the BOEs decision not to build the expansion for Richard Montgomery, our community is working to find interim solutions for the following issues:
 - o Inadequate science laboratory space including safety issues and bench space for students to conduct experiments,
 - o Find safe and suitable location for portables that does not impinge on parking.
 - Pursue the possibility of roundtable discussions to address the development of Crown Farm HS.

A meeting was held with BOE member Smondrowski on Monday, April 16 to discuss RMHS addition. She agreed to pursue discussions on a science annex with MCPS staff.

- Continue to advocate for the revitalization of Twinbrook Elementary.
- Continue to support the building and opening of Bayard Rustin E.S. for fall 2018.
- Establish a support mechanism for families transitioning to other ESs within the cluster.
- Continue to support JWMS on the public-private partnership with MSI to secure a turf field.

May Cluster Events and Happenings:

- Quadrennial Cluster Meetings: The cluster is continuing to plan for the Cluster Meeting with the BOE on May 17. A meeting was held in April with BOE staff to discuss agenda, and expectations.
