Upcoming January Respect Life Events

* **January 25th:** Memorial Service for the Unborn at the Utah State Capitol at 12:30 pm to honor babies that have been killed by abortion since an injunction was placed on Utah's trigger law. Following the service, a procession will lead to the Memorial for the Unborn at Mount Calvary Catholic Cemetery. Beginning at 1:00 pm, church bells across the state of Utah will ring for 29 minutes or 1,746 seconds. *Each second will represent one of the babies lost to abortion since the injunction.*

* **January 28th:** Respect for the Dignity of Life Day at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church in Sandy from 9:00am-Noon. Mass will begin at 9:00 am followed by discussions on Human Dignity and Building a Culture of Life, Mental Health Awareness: Accompanying those who suffer, and The Joshua Project-Raising up Joshua's through outreach to the youth of the diocese.
